Many pets will be lost at least once in their lifetime. Losing a pet can be a traumatic experience for both the owner and the pet. Pets go missing every day. Show you care. Licensing your cat or dog helps return your pet home safely.

The money received for pet licensing allows us to:

- return lost pets
- feed and shelter stray animals
- rescue lost and homeless animals that are injured or need veterinary care
- teach children about animal safety
- keep our neighbourhoods safe for pets and people

Do you know?

- Failure to license a dog or cat every year may result in a \$240 ticket. If you are taken to court, the maximum penalty is a \$5,000 fine.
- You may keep a maximum of six animals at a time including cats, dogs, rabbits and ferrets. Of these six, no more than three may be dogs.
