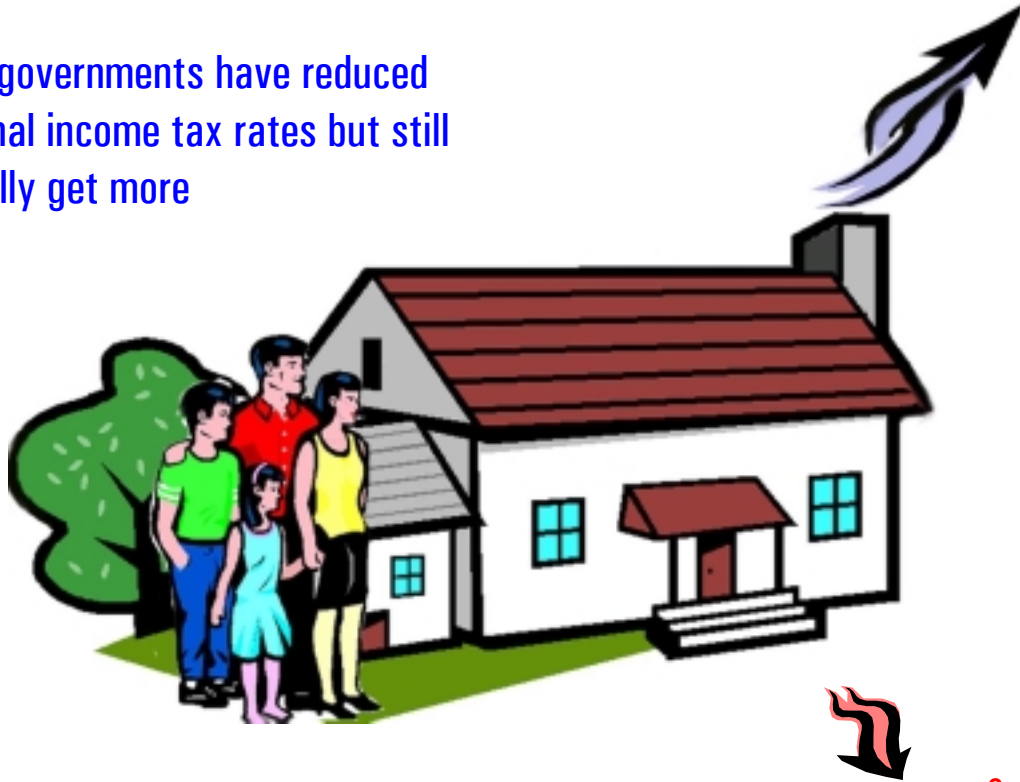


Who's Actually Getting your Money?

Assuming a family of four (parents and two kids under 18) makes an average income of \$85,200¹ and receives a 2002 wage increase of 3% of \$2,550.

An average Toronto family pays an additional **\$450** of Income Tax to Senior Governments

The senior governments have reduced your personal income tax rates but still automatically get more



while the same family pays only **\$79**² more in Property Tax to City of Toronto
