CLEAN AND BEAUTIFUL CITY INITIATIVE

ANNUAL REVIEW

Background:

The Clean and Beautiful City three year Five-Point Action Plan was approved by City Council at its meeting on November 30, December 1 and 2, 2004. The plan provided for \$8.6 million in new capital budget projects and \$13.8 million in new operating funds over the period of 2005-2007. The funding supports 48 projects housed and delivered throughout City divisions.

The 2005 Annual Review report entitled “Keeping Toronto Clean & Beautiful is up to All of Us – Annual Review 2005” highlights the range of projects dedicated to making Toronto cleaner and more beautiful, and project accomplishments in 2005.
