## **BRIEFING NOTE**

### Transportation Services – Summary of Waived Fees/Costs for Street Event Permits

---

#### **Issue/Background:**

At its meeting of November 4, 2005, the Budget Advisory Committee in considering an overview of the 2006 Transportation Services' Operating Budget submission, requested information respecting the amount of revenue that may not be collected annually as a result of the waiver of fees for special event permits and any costs for road closures, signage, clean-up after special events that cannot be collected from third parties, excluding staff time and overtime, to support the special events.

#### **Key Point(s):**

Below is a summary of waived costs for street event and banner permits as of November 22, 2005 for the Toronto and East York District only (other districts have not reported any waived fees/costs):

#### **WAIVED COSTS FOR STREET EVENT PERMITS**

##### Road Closures

(28 applications – City Divisions/Police, Provincial, Federal): 92 days x \$68.64 \$ 6,452.16

##### City Council Waived Fees

(1 application – Salsa on St. Clair): 3 days x \$68.64 \$ 205.92

**Sub-total \$ 6,658.08**

#### **WAIVED COSTS FOR BANNER PERMITS**

##### Banner Permits (4 applications – City Divisions):

Toronto Zoo \$ 1,394.97

Live With Culture \$ 3,611.76

Homes For the Aged \$ 177.00

20 Minute MakeOver \$ 225.72

**Sub-total \$ 5,409.45**

**Total Fees Waived \$12,067.53**

**Conclusion:**

As at the November 22, 2005, the fees waived for various street event and banner permits issued by Transportation Services totaled \$12,067.53.
