As provided for in ARTICLE IX of CH. 771, Taxation, Third Party Sign Tax, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, this Notice of Objection is required to be served on the Chief Building Official of the City of Toronto within 60 days from the day of mailing or delivery by hand of the Notice of Assessment and shall be served on the Chief Building Official by personal service or by registered mail.

The personal information on this form is collected under the authority of ss. 267 and 270 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, and Chapter 771, Taxation, Third Party Sign Tax of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, and will be used for assessment of tax, interest and applicable penalties owing under Chapter 771, issuance of notice of assessment of amounts owing and issuance of rebates under Chapter 771, enforcement of unpaid tax amounts, creating aggregate statistical reports, enforcement of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 694, Signs, General, Chapter 771, Taxation, Third Party Sign Tax, and any other applicable sign by-law of the City of Toronto, and contacting sign owner(s) or authorized agent(s).
