Special Services Unit

Toronto Children's Services in partnership with community agencies provides enhanced services to licensed child care programs to ensure the successful inclusion of children with extra support needs. This model of service is called Every Child Belongs.

The Special Services Unit of Toronto Children's Services has 29 Resource Educators who provide enhanced



services to children, their families, staff and providers in licensed child care programs. These supports include:

- Regular visits to programs
- Early identification and intervention
- Individual consultation
- Program consultation
- Community and program training
- Program adaptations
- Staff, provider and parent training
- Service coordination and referral
- Enhanced staffing/intensive resource referrals when needed
