During the construction of Menkes Gibson Square, Gibson House Museum will be open for school field trips and other activities, but **access to the museum has changed**. Please follow these instructions and refer to the map for a safe and efficient arrival at the museum.

School Buses

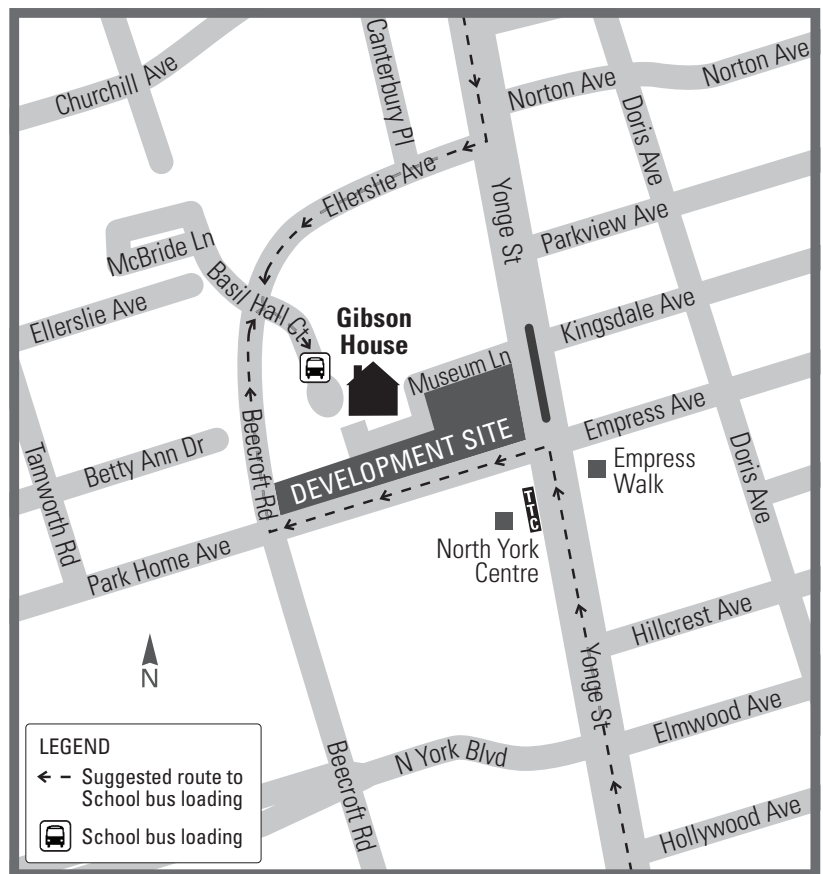
The school bus loading zone is on Basil Hall Court, a cul-de-sac off Beecroft Ave. (west of the museum).

TTC

From the North York Centre subway station cross Park Home Ave. and walk north on the west side of Yonge St. to our new pedestrian access just past the construction site. Please stay on the marked pedestrian path, away from traffic.

Walking

You can visit Gibson House from the new Yonge St. pedestrian access just north of the construction site, or from the west via Basil Hall Court.



Private Vehicles

Call the museum for driveway and parking directions.

Yonge St. and Park Home Ave. are NOT recommended for bus loading during the construction as they will be staging areas for trucks.

Take extra time to arrive and use caution when approaching the site. Pay attention to the construction traffic warden.

Construction begins November 2010 and is anticipated to last 2-3 years.
