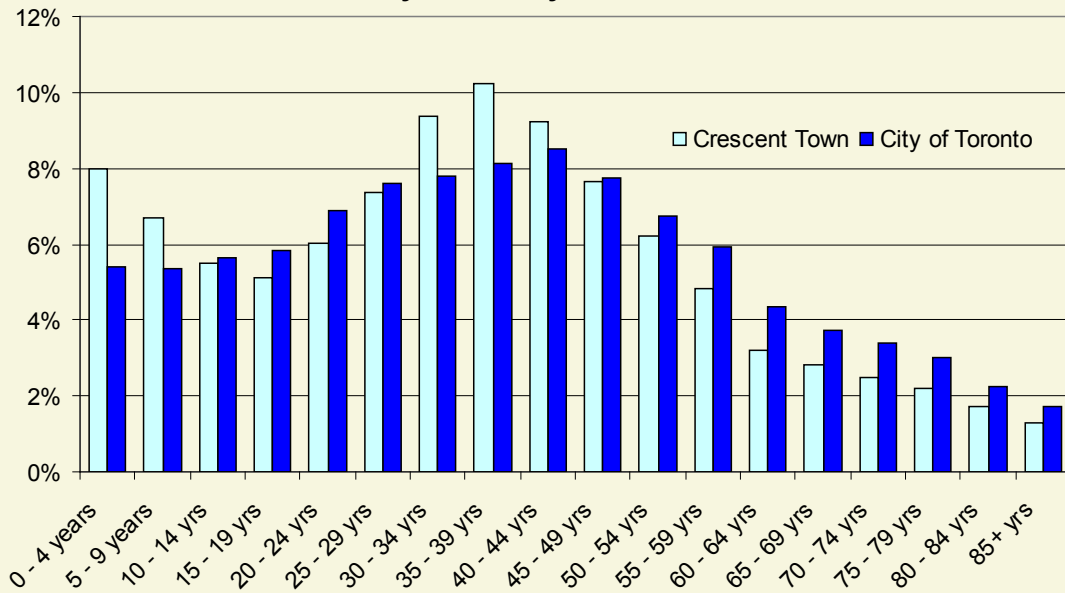
### Age & Sex Profile



### Population Change 2001-2006

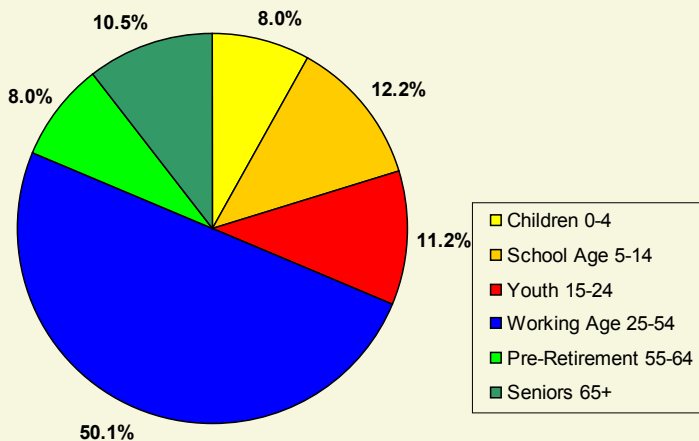

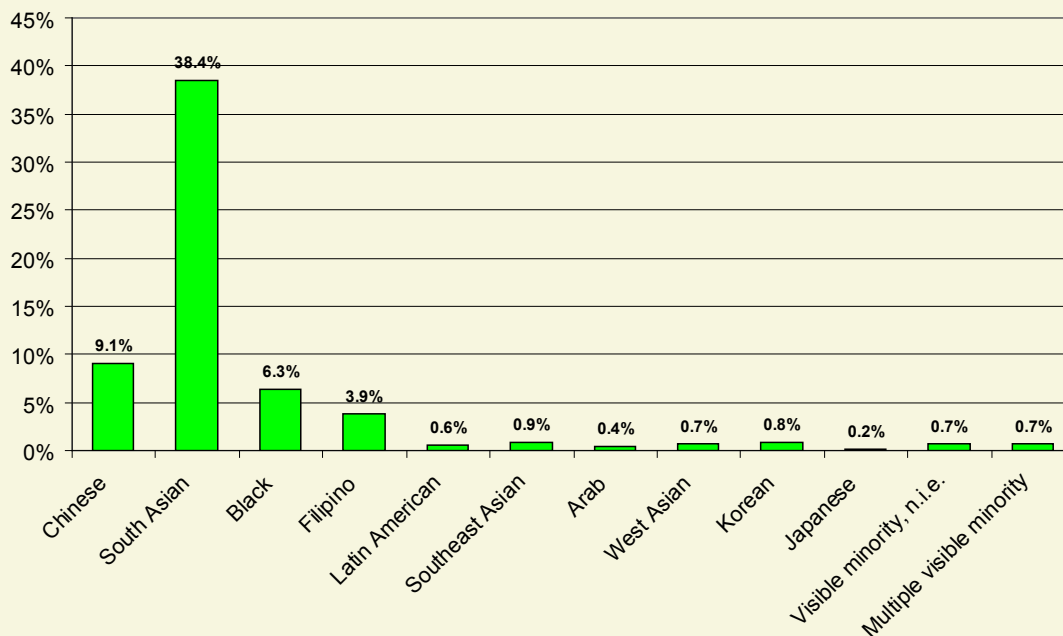


### Source of Post-secondary Education (Age 25-64) Priority Area vs City of Toronto

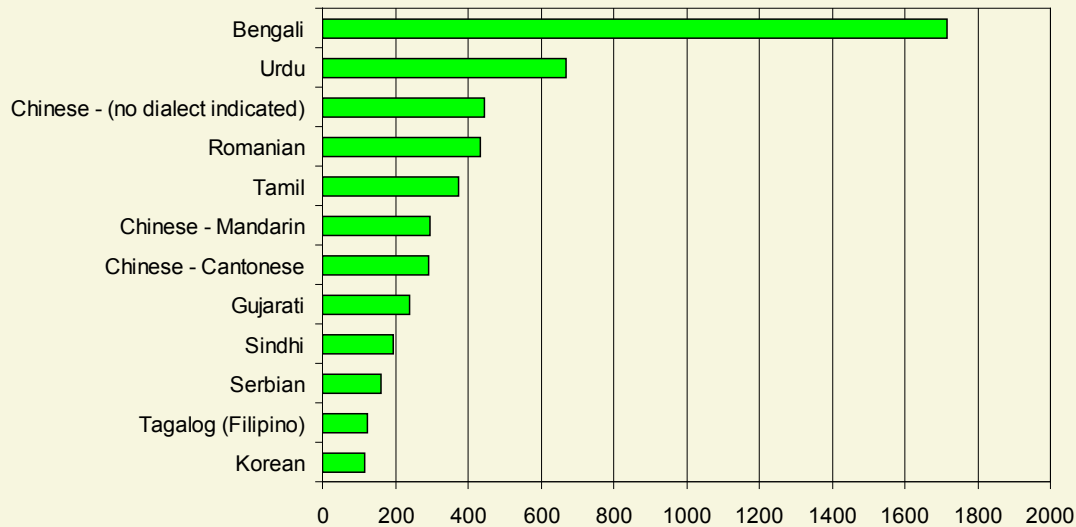

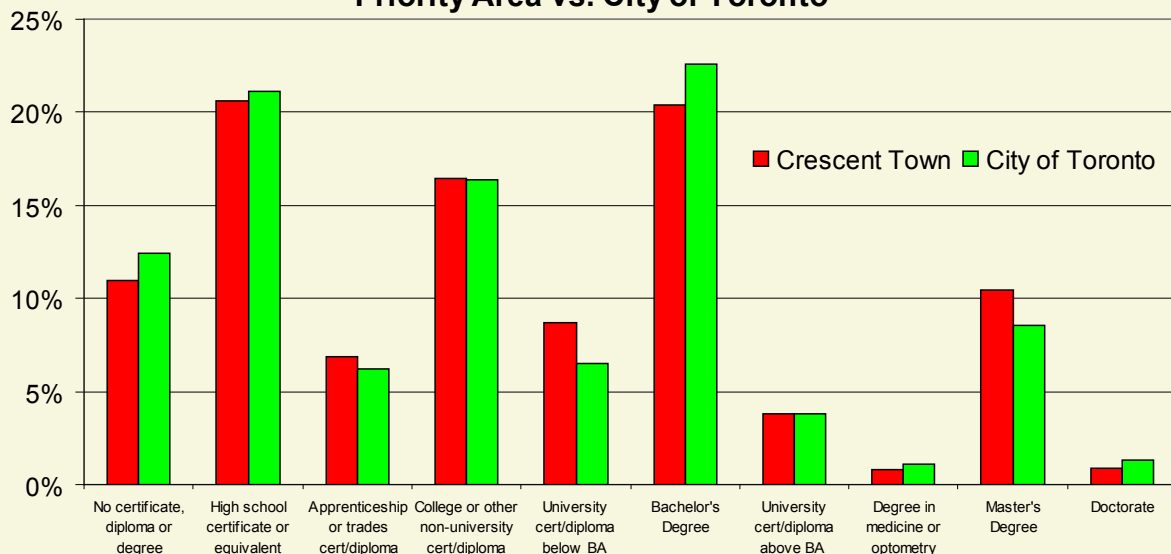

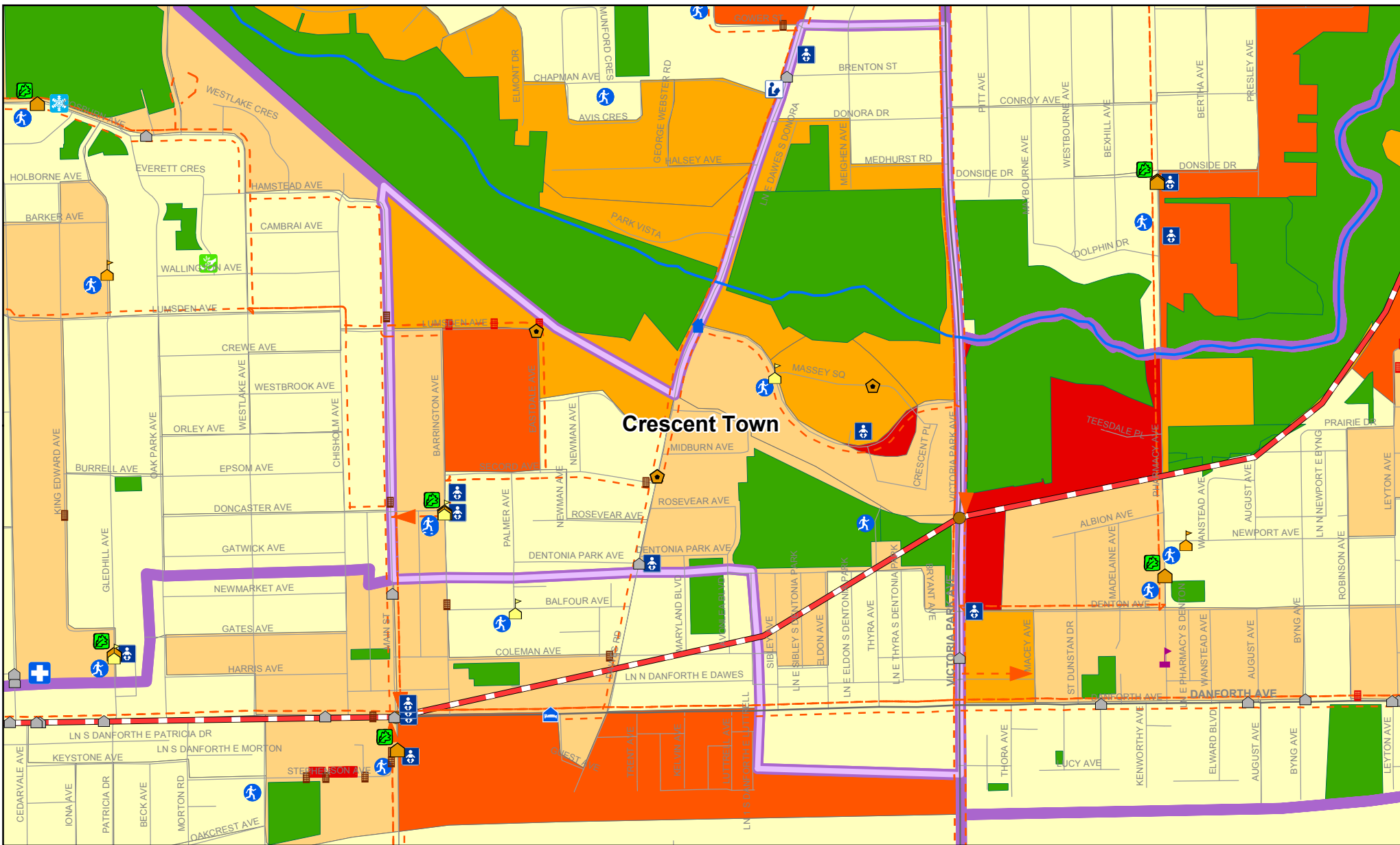

# Human Services - Crescent Town Priority Area

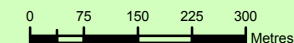
