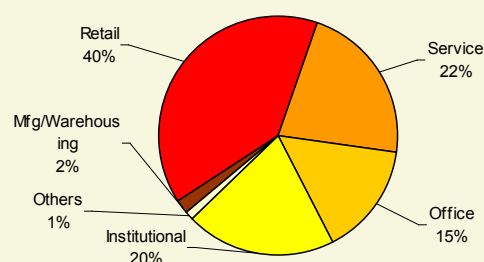

Total Employment by Sector

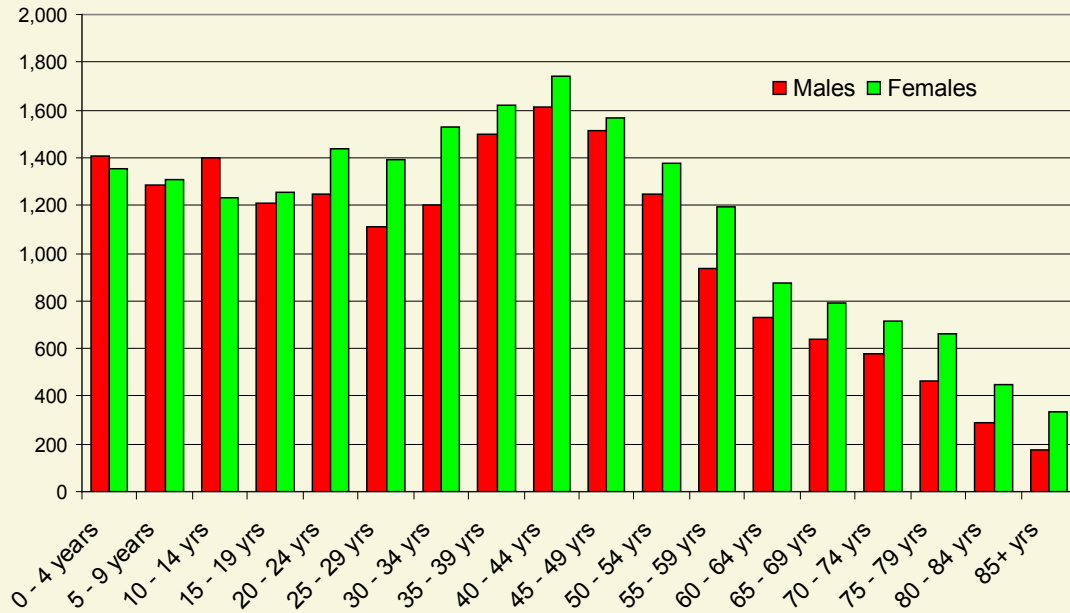


Part-Time Employment by Sector

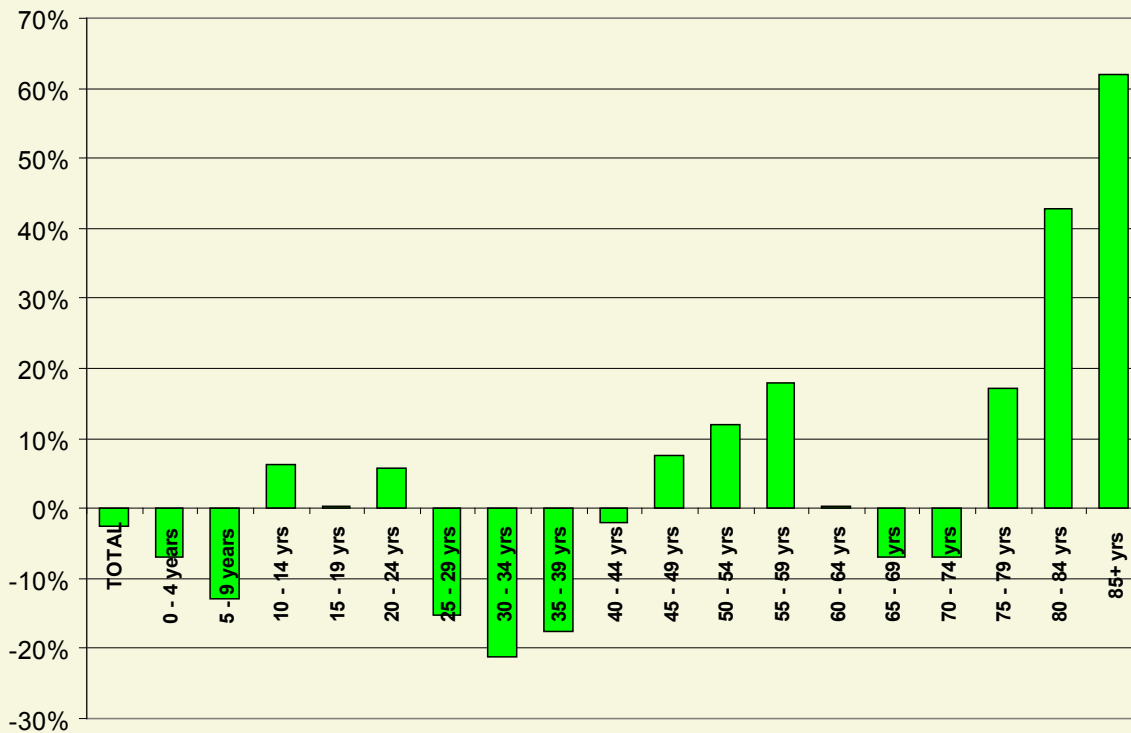

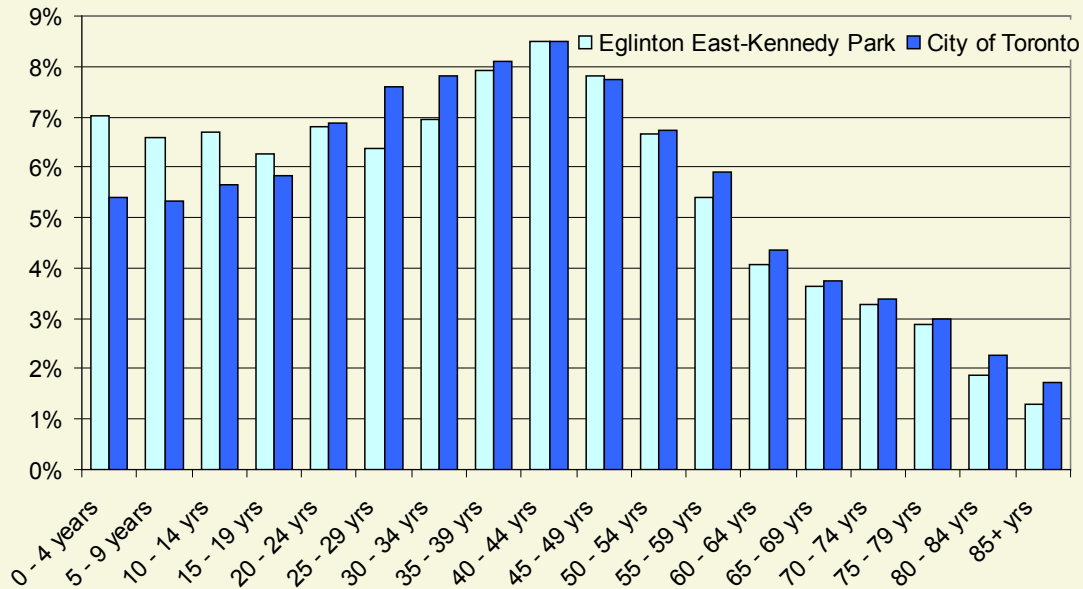
Age & Sex Profile



Population Change 2001-2006

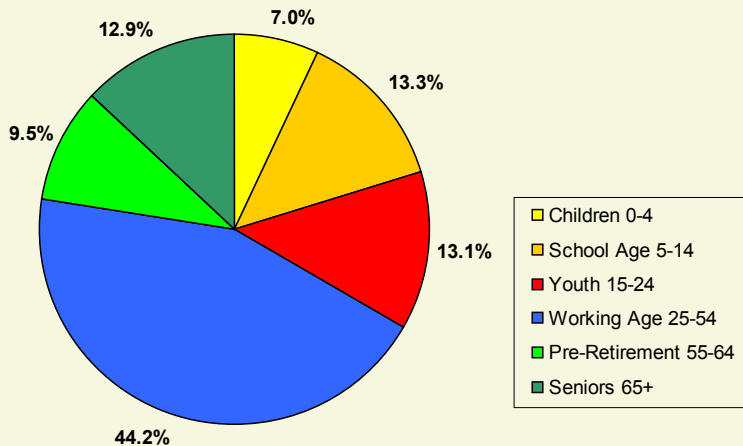

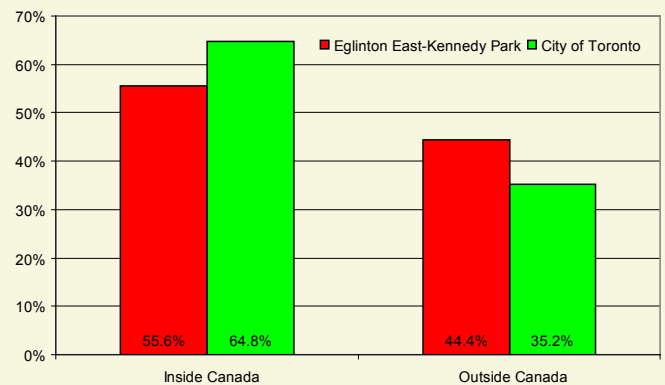

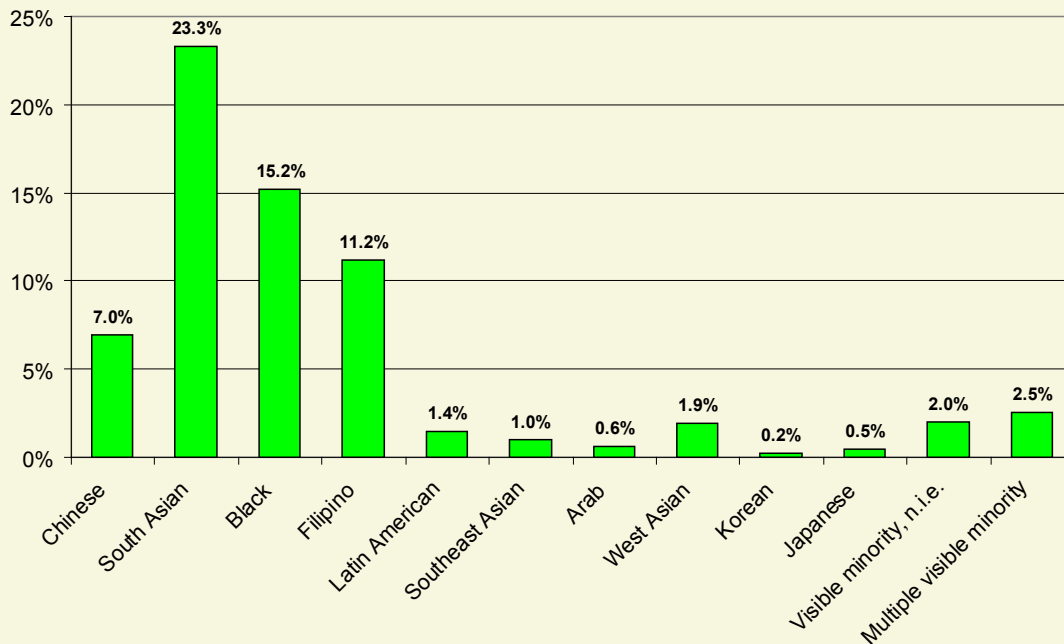


**Source of Post-secondary Education
(Age 25-64) Priority Area vs City of Toronto**



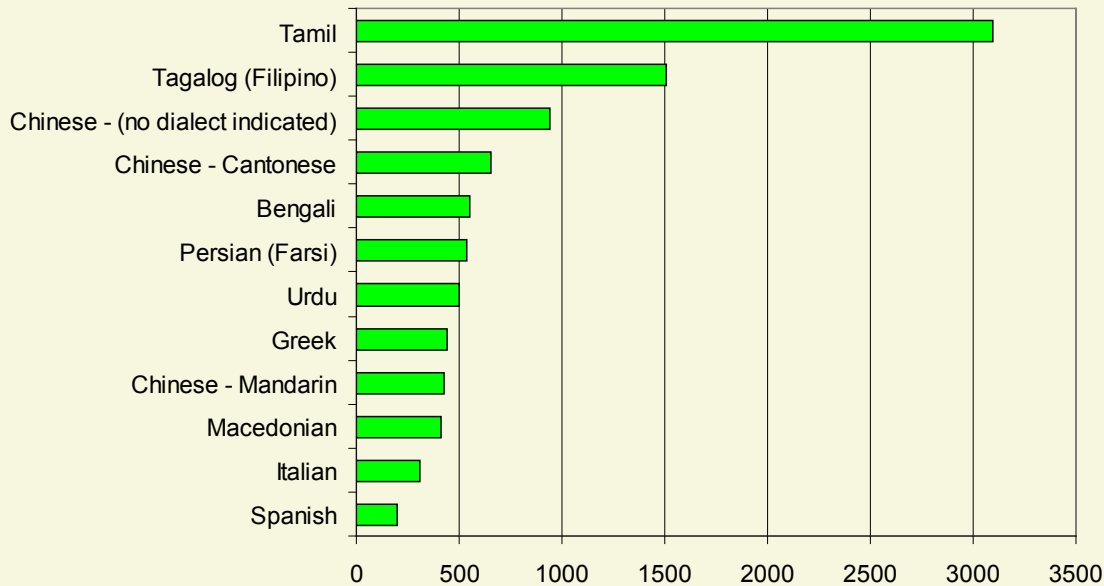

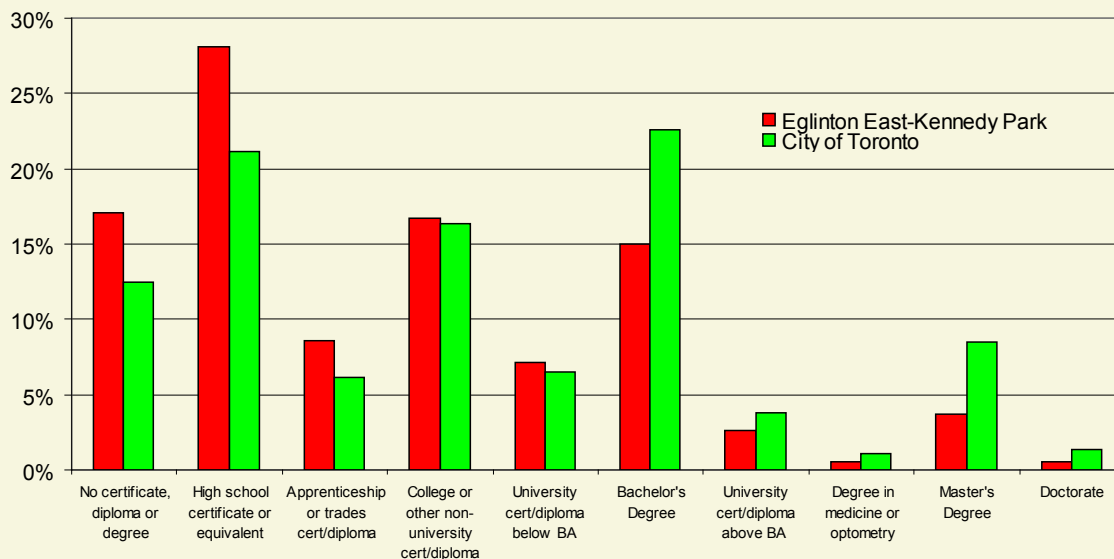

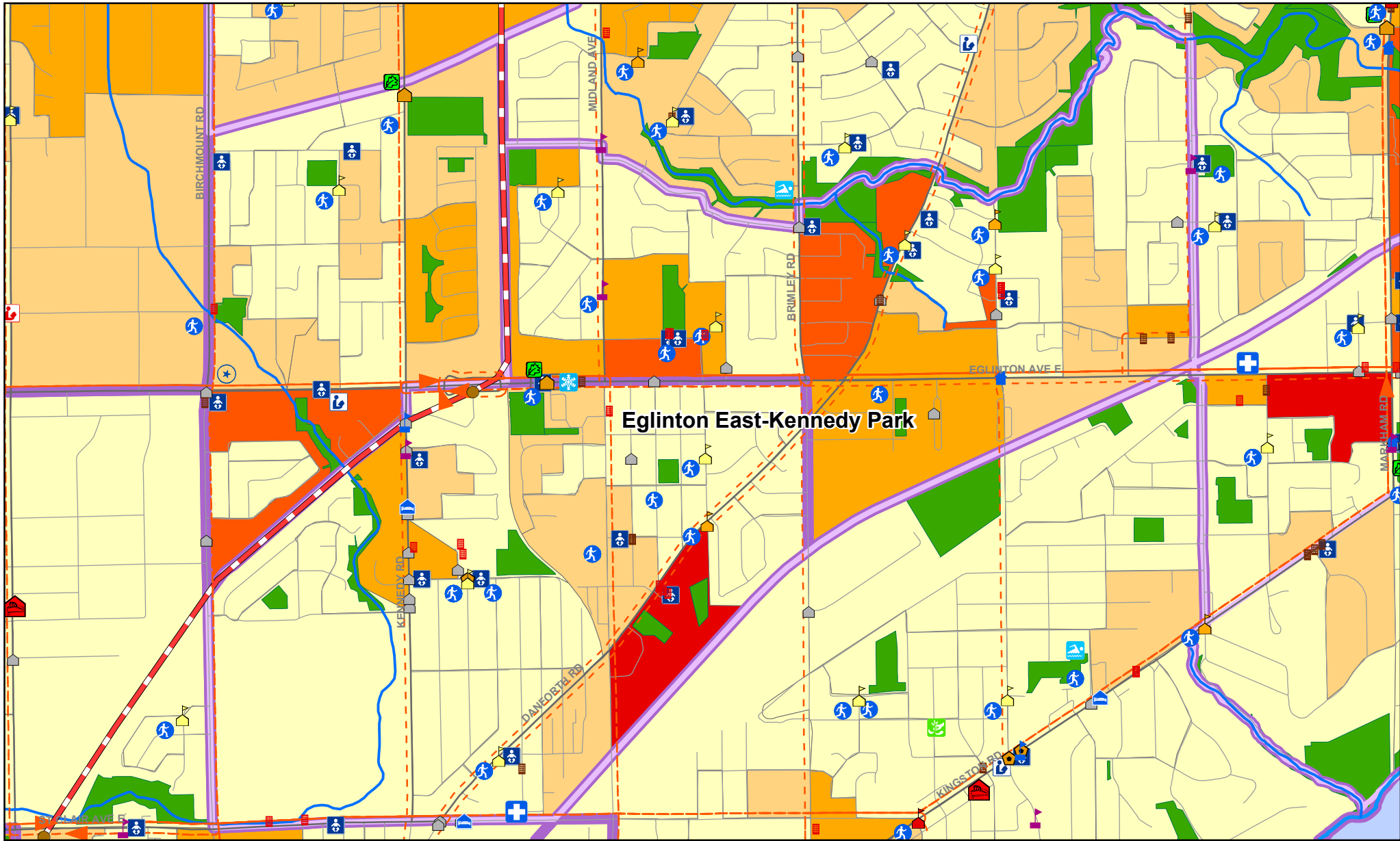

Human Services - Eglinton East-Kennedy Park Priority Area

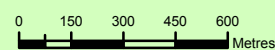
