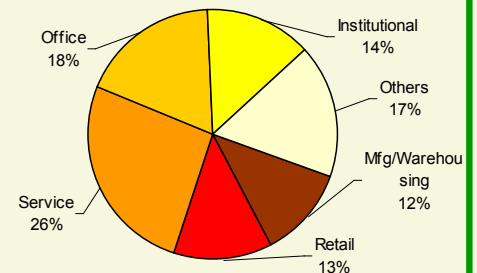

Total Employment by Sector

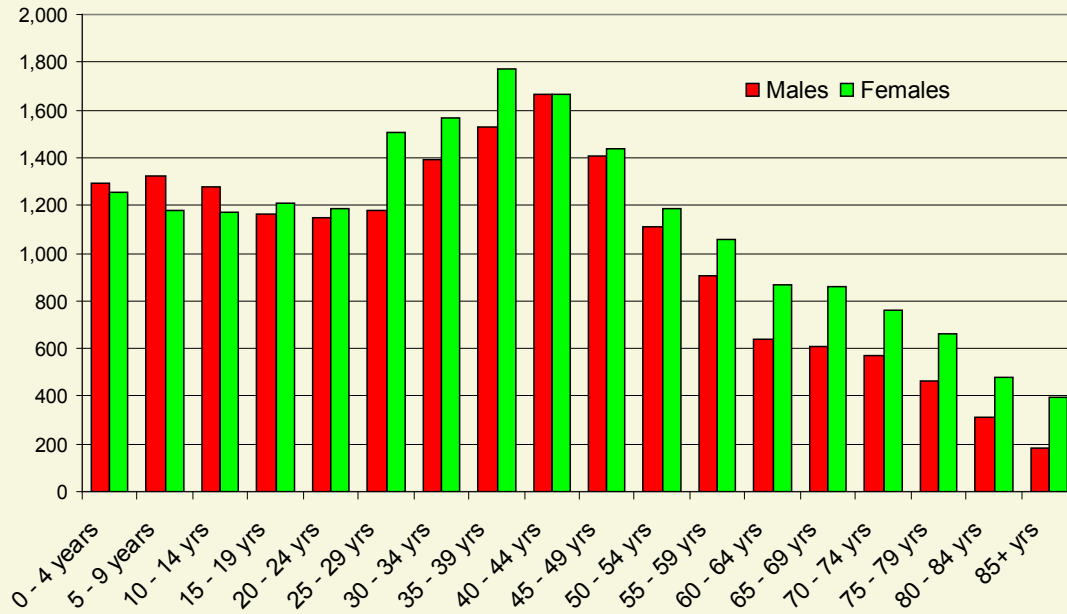


Part-Time Employment by Sector

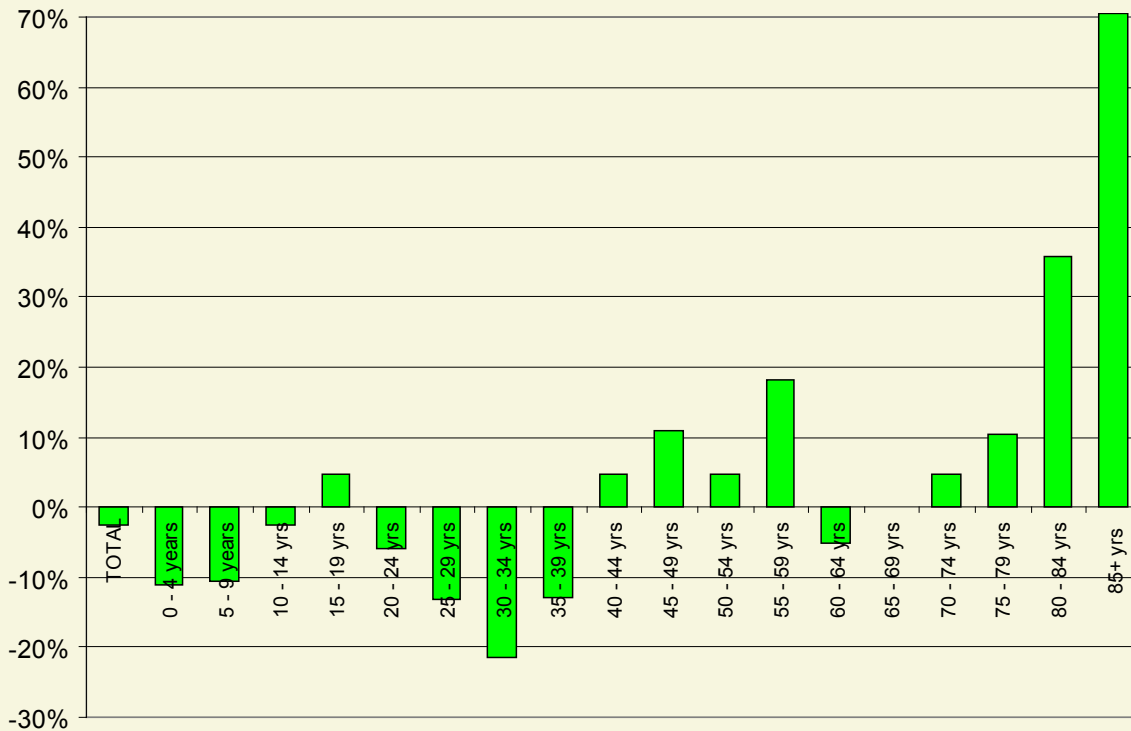

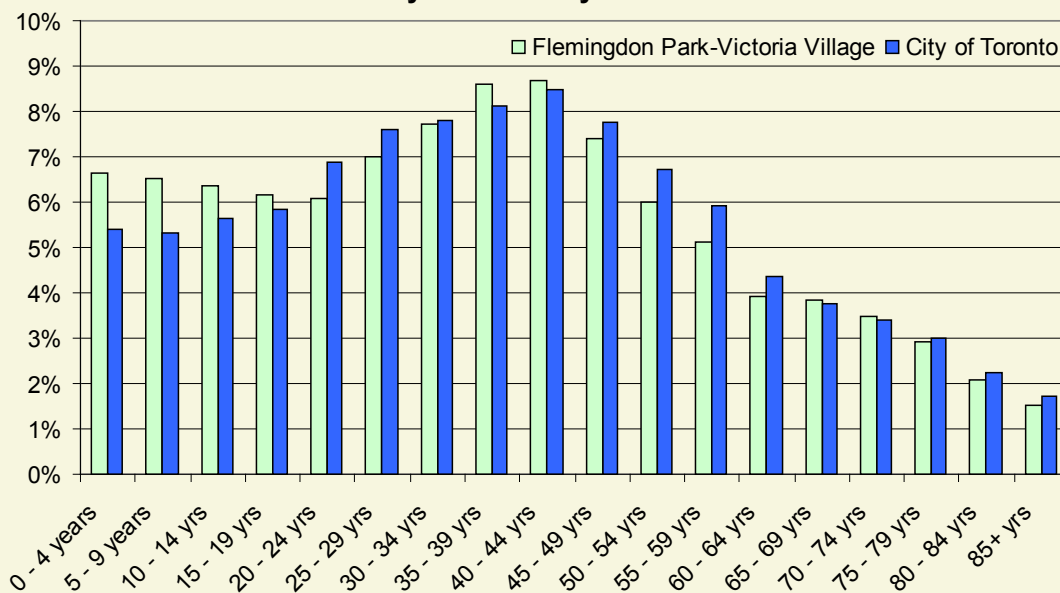
Age & Sex Profile



Population Change 2001-2006

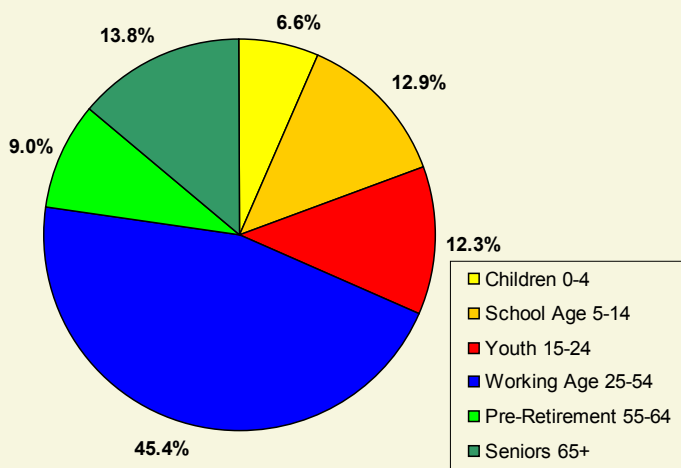


Population Age Group Proportions Priority Area vs City of Toronto

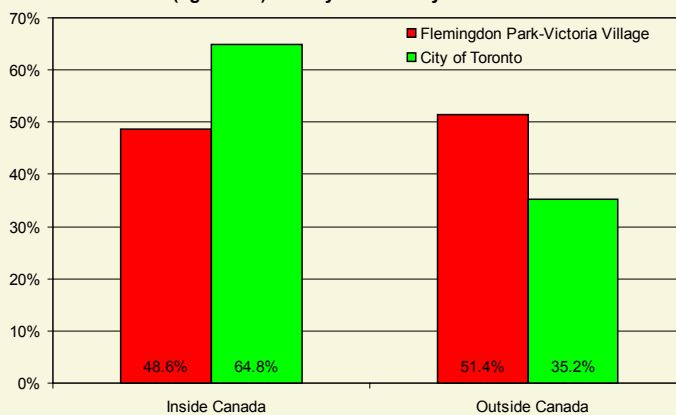

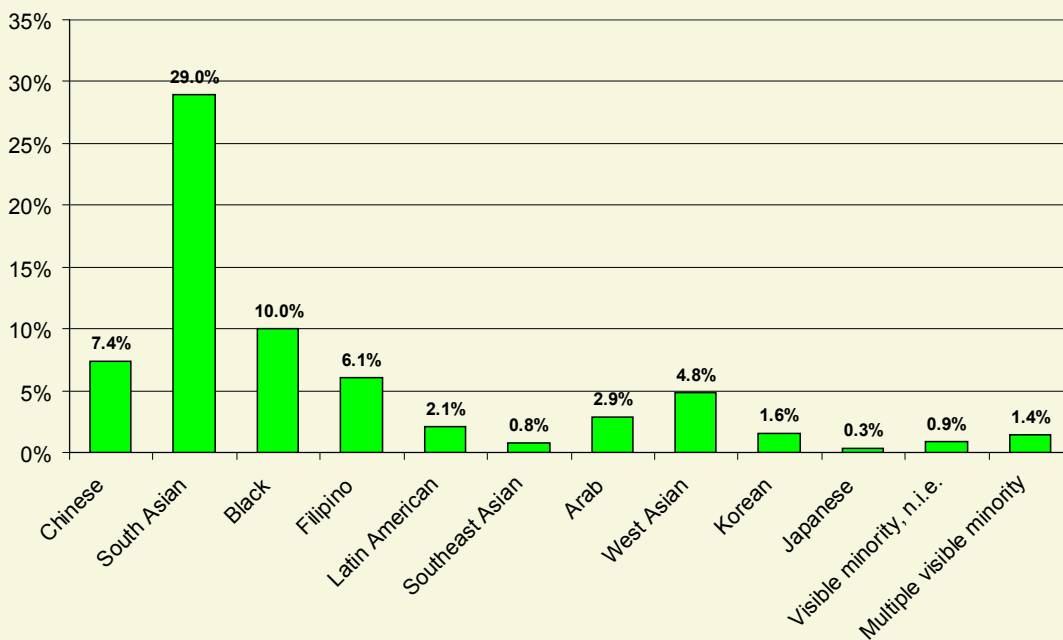


Source of Post-secondary Education (Age 25-64) Priority Area vs City of Toronto



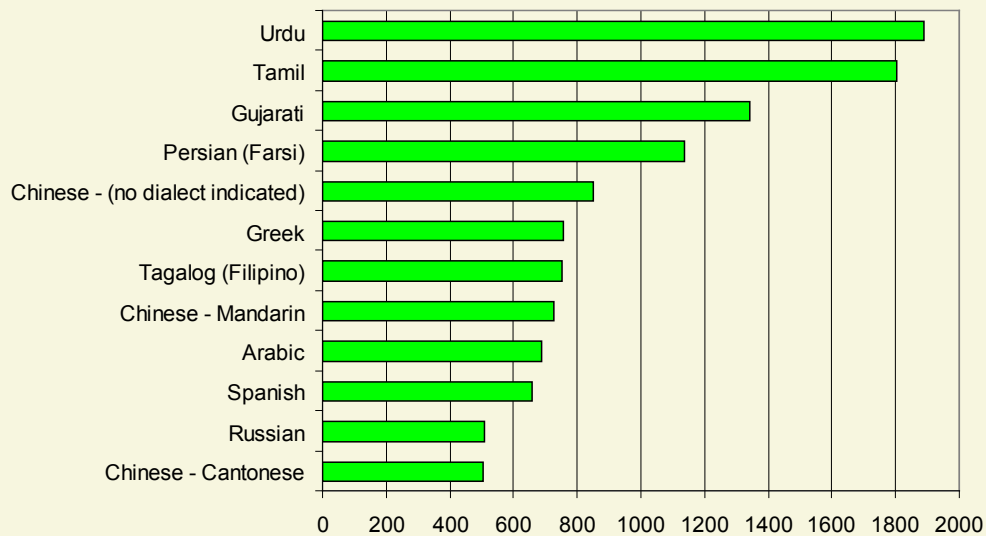

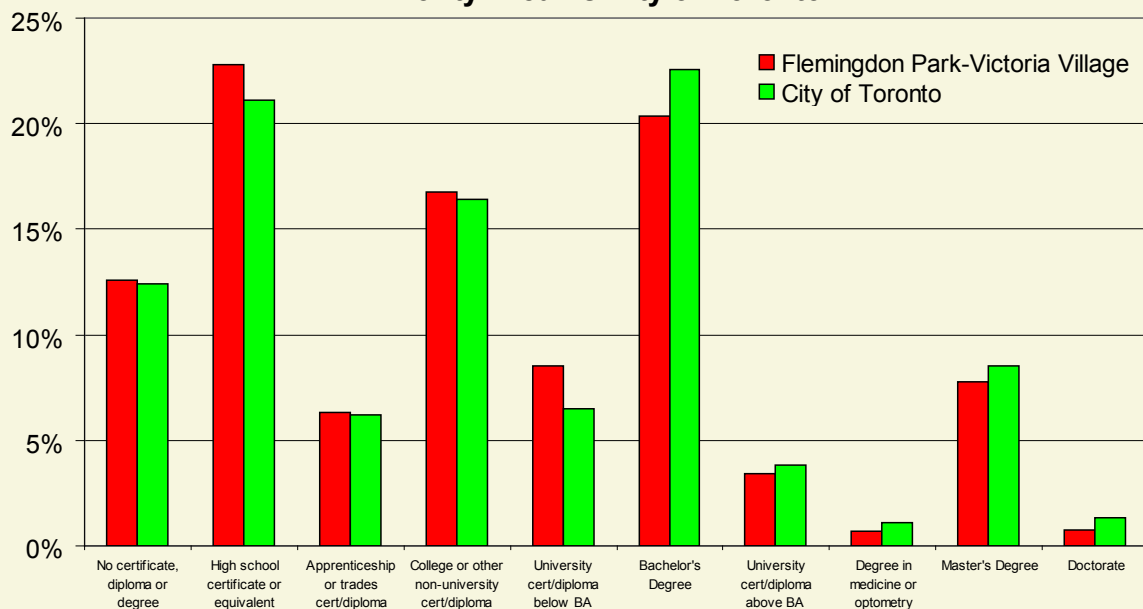

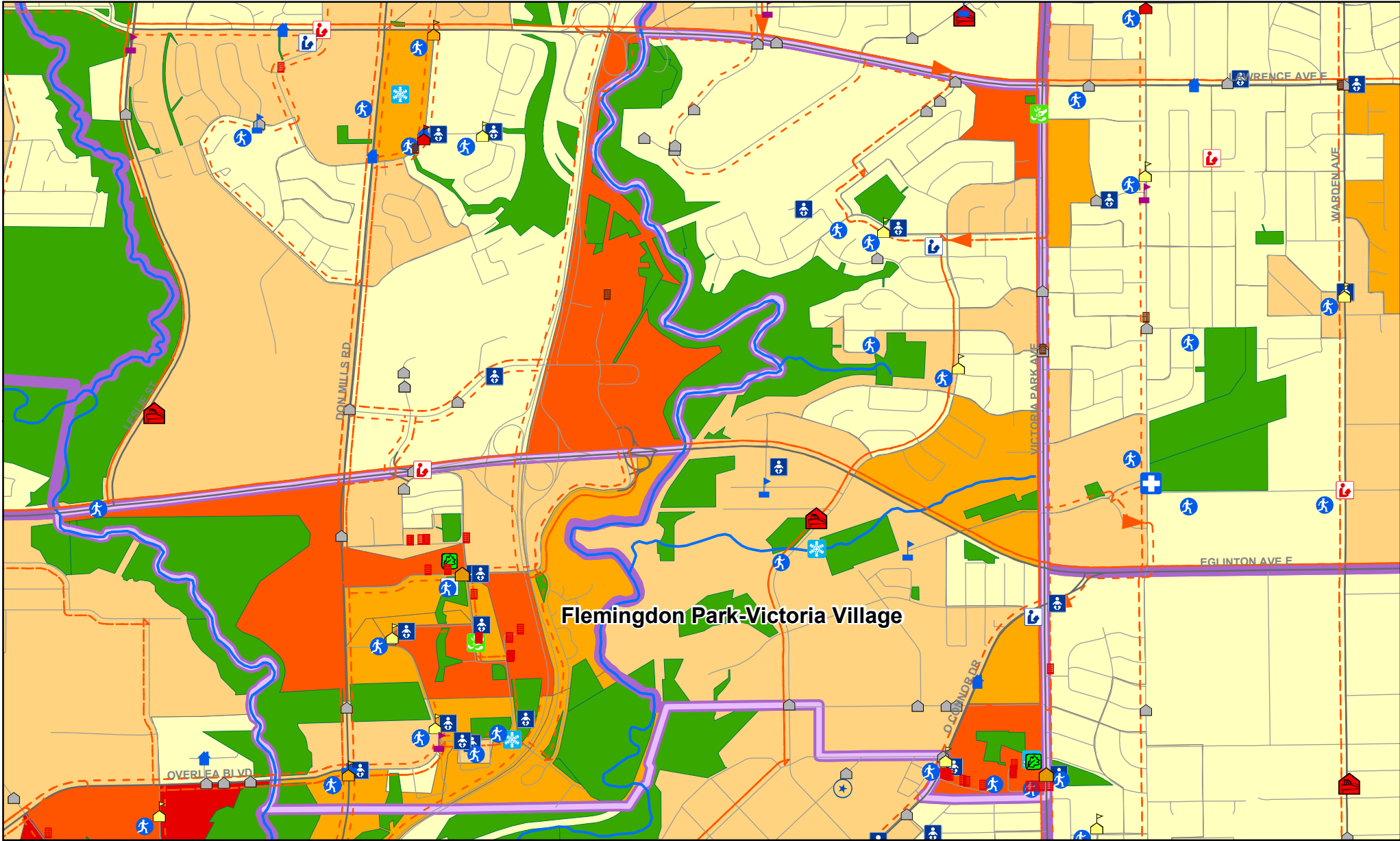

Human Services - Flemingdon Park-Victoria Village Priority Area



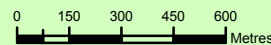
