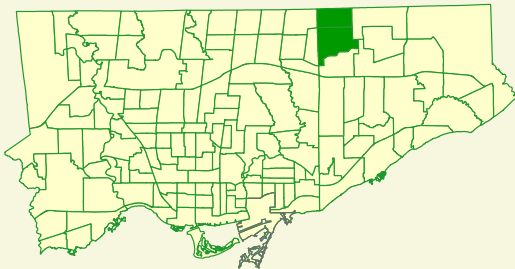

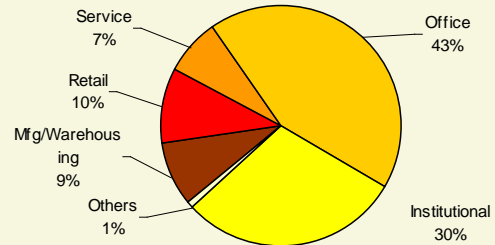

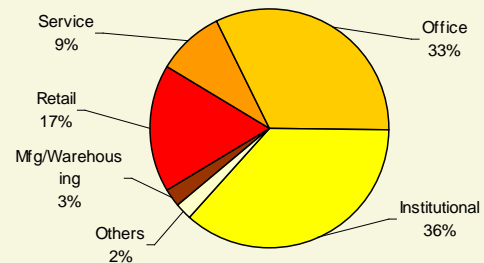

Total Employment by Sector

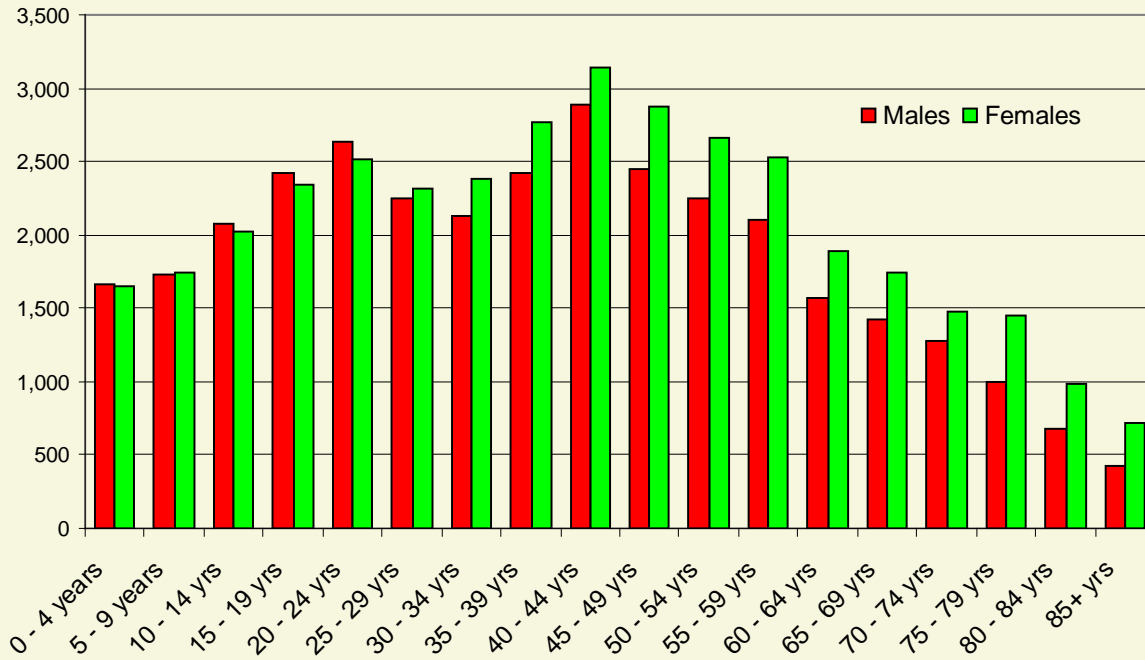


Part-Time Employment by Sector

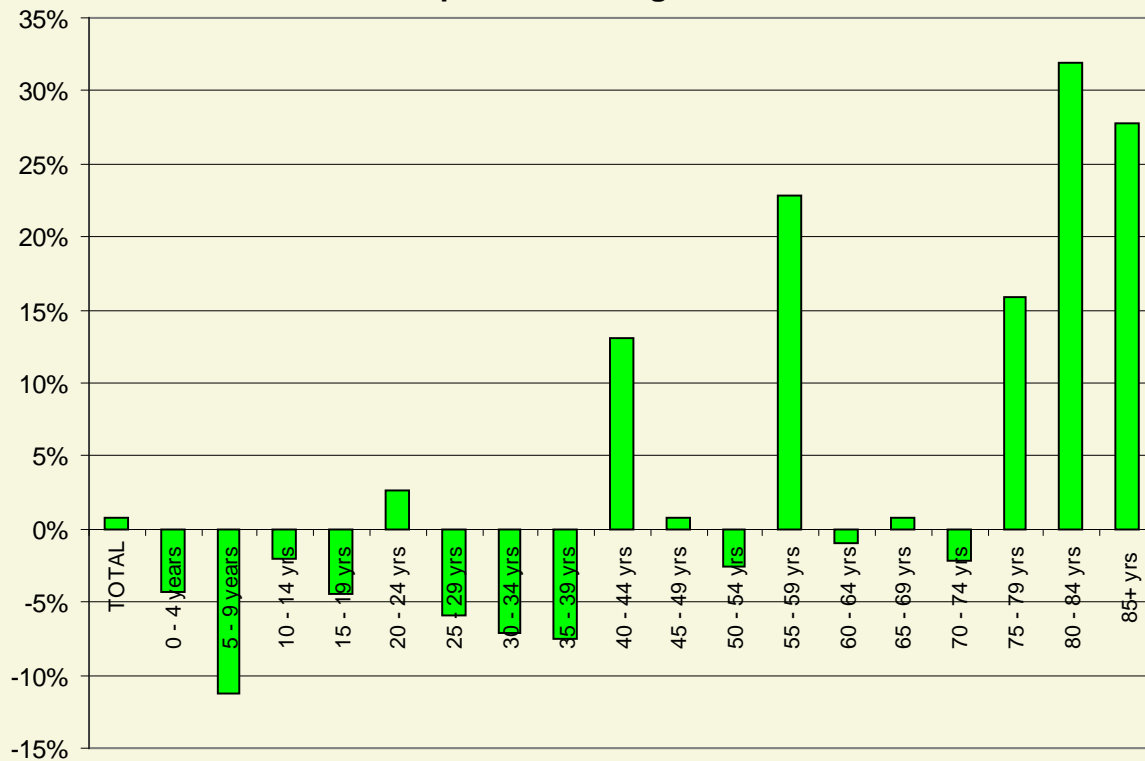

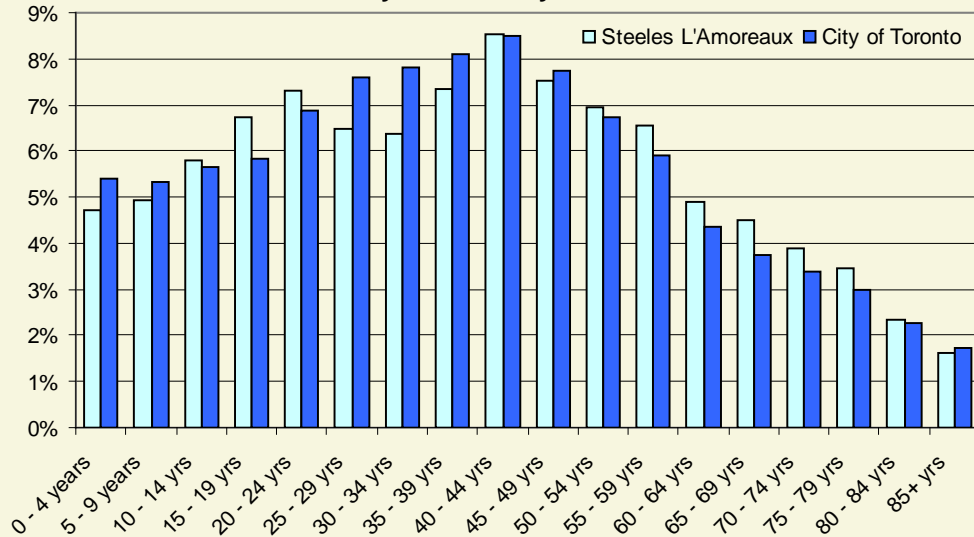
### Age & Sex Profile



### Population Change 2001-2006

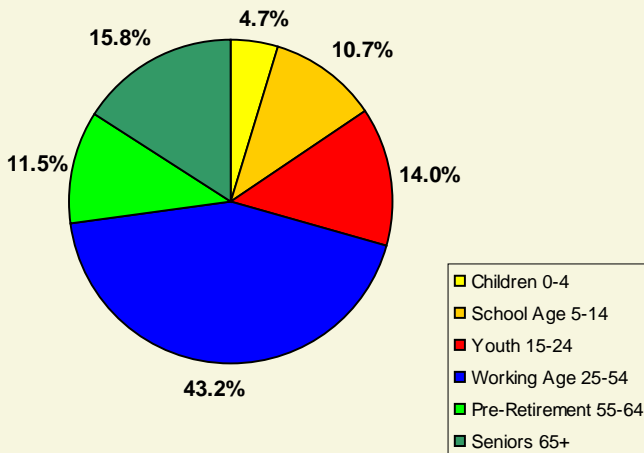

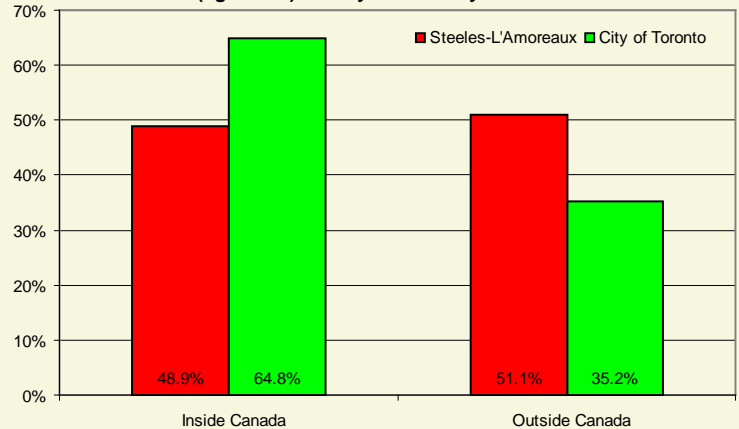

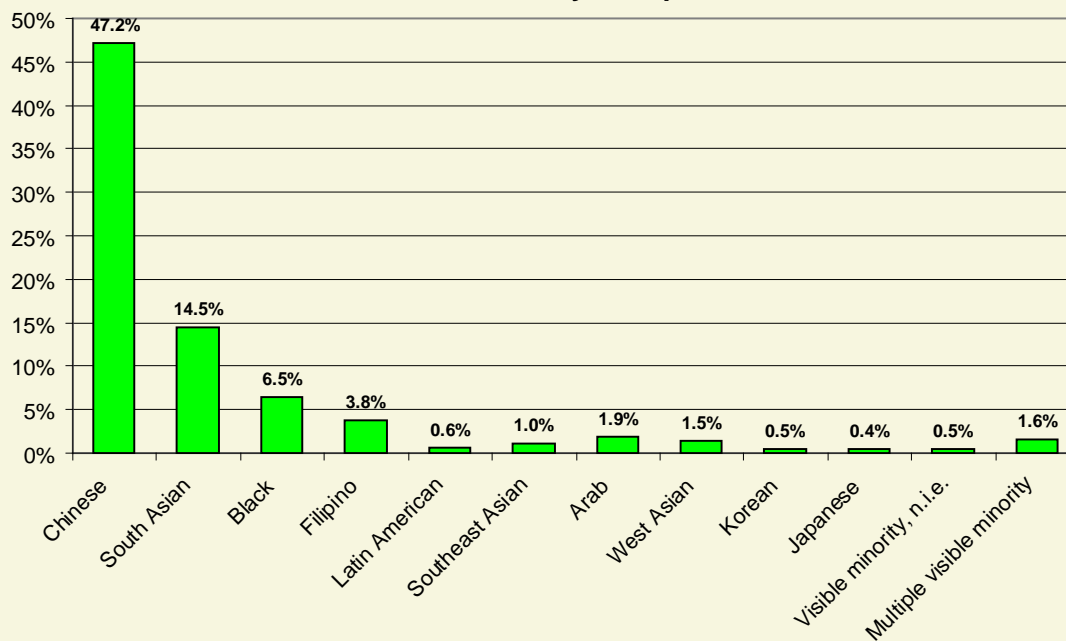


**Source of Post-secondary Education  
(Age 25-64) Priority Area vs City of Toronto**



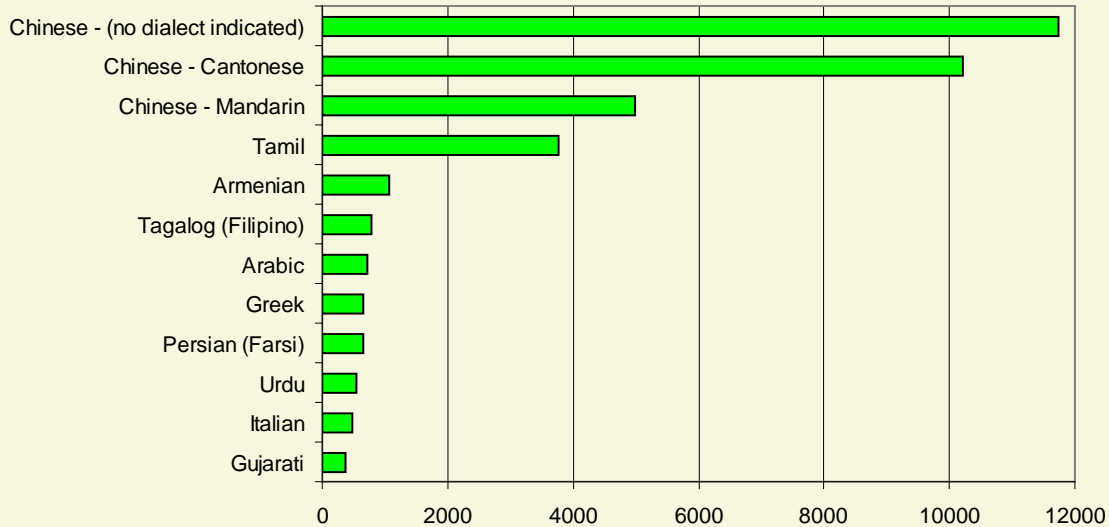

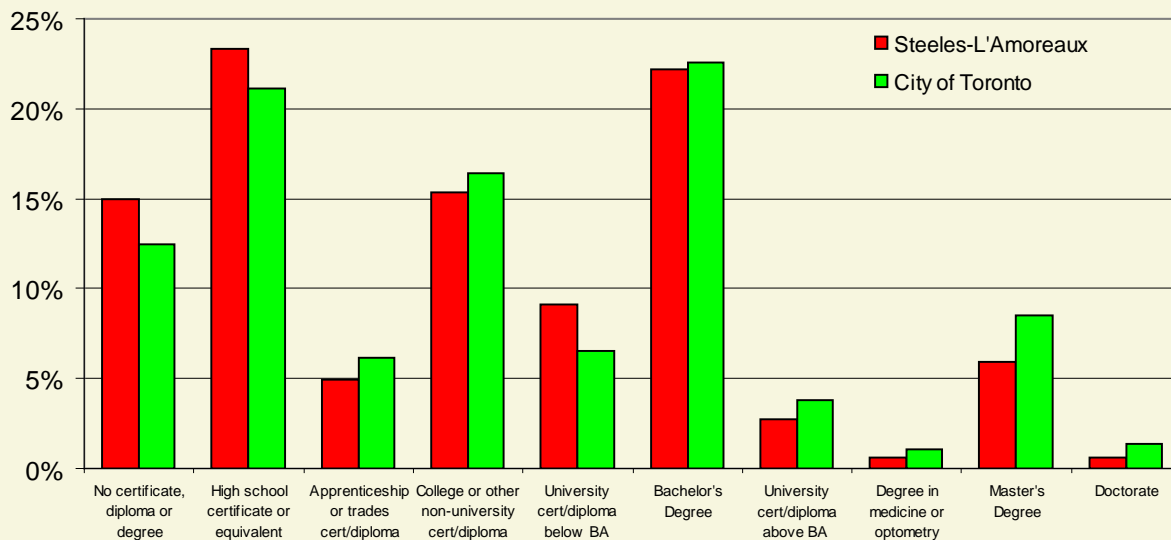

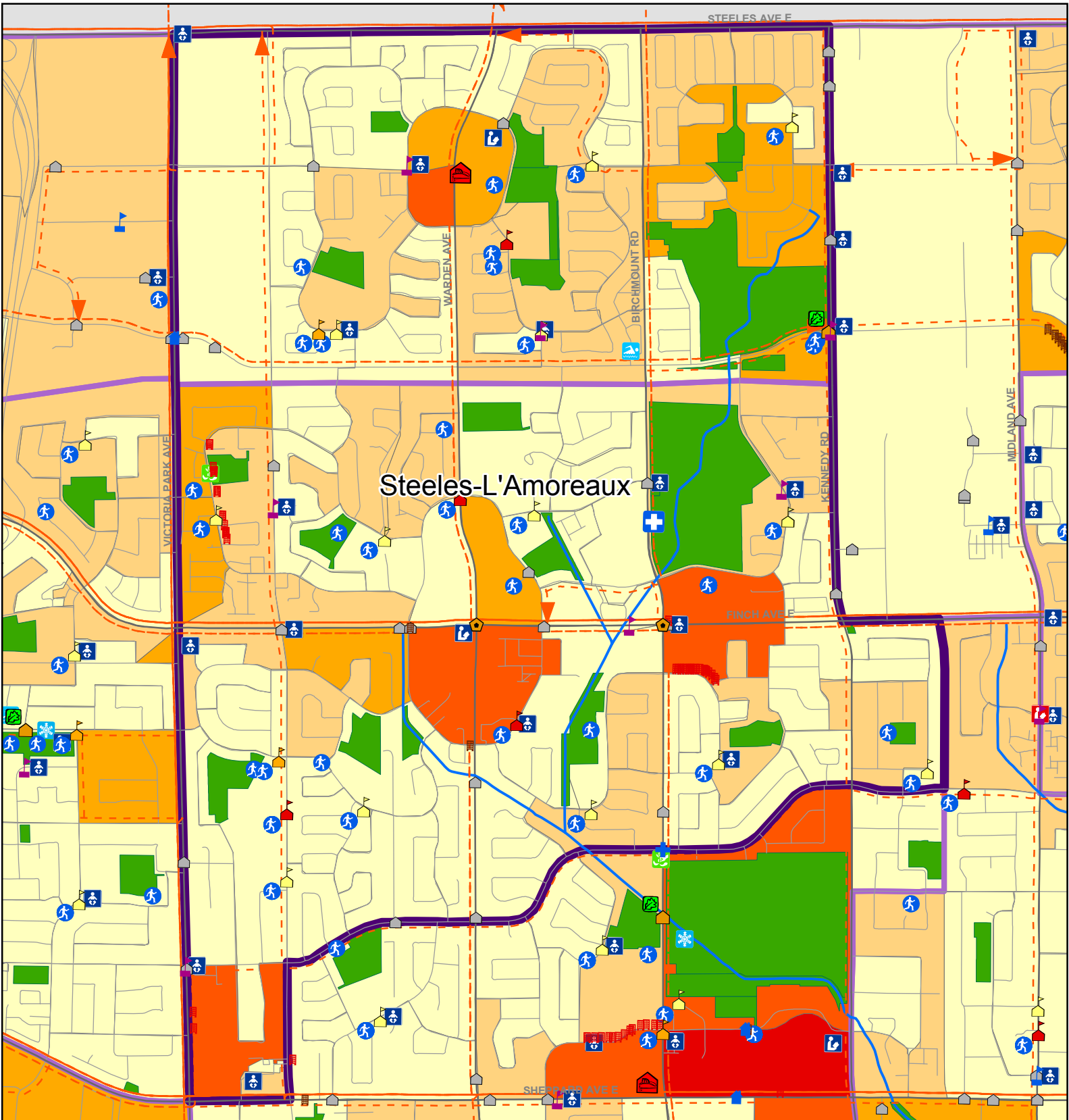
