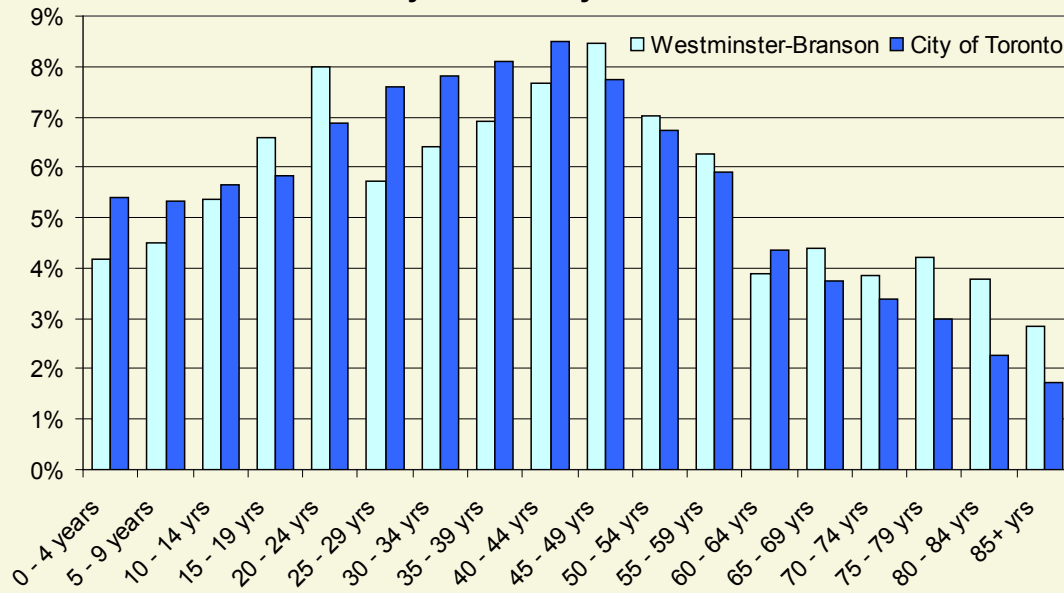
Age & Sex Profile



Population Change 2001-2006

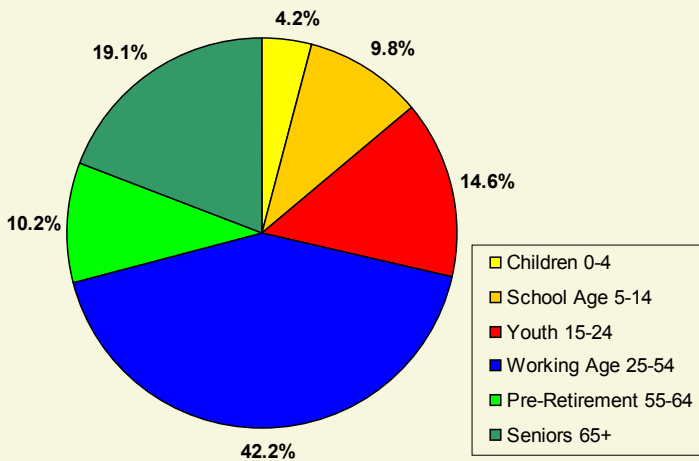


**Population Age Group Proportions
Priority Area vs City of Toronto**

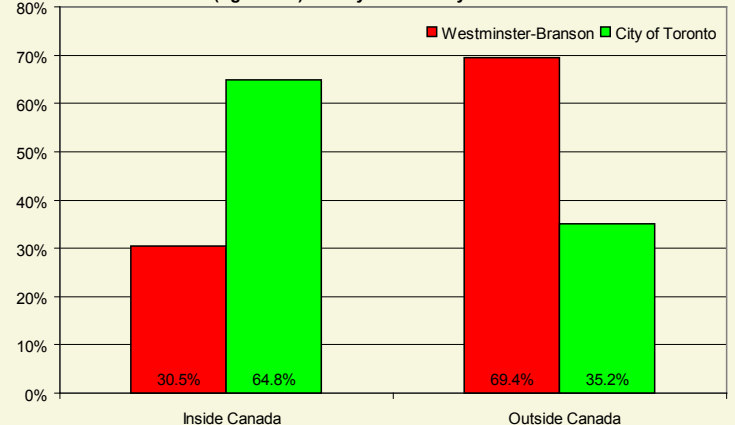

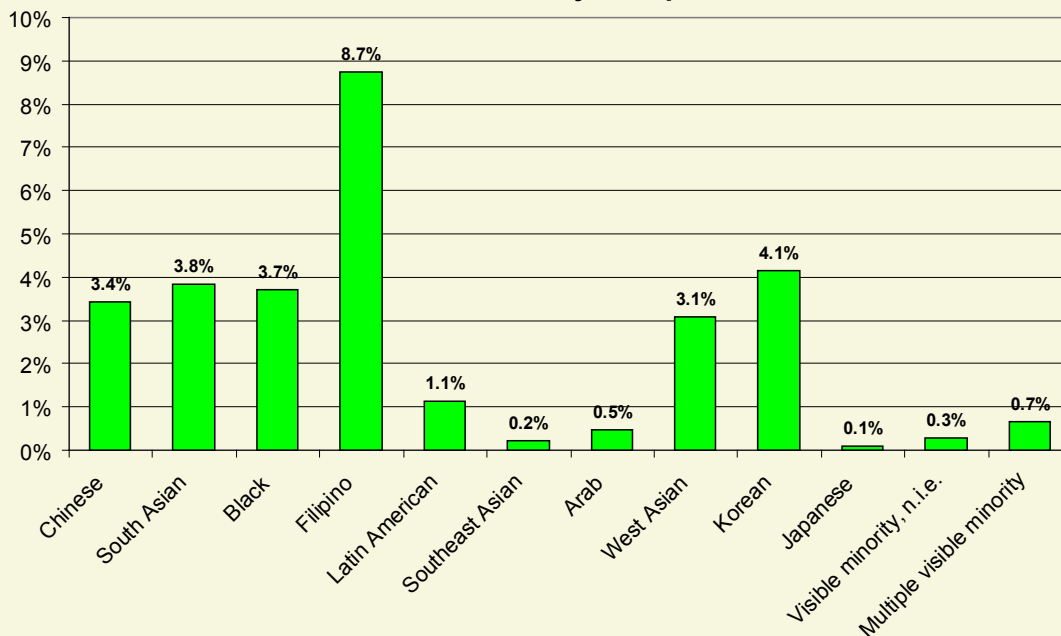


**Source of Post-secondary Education

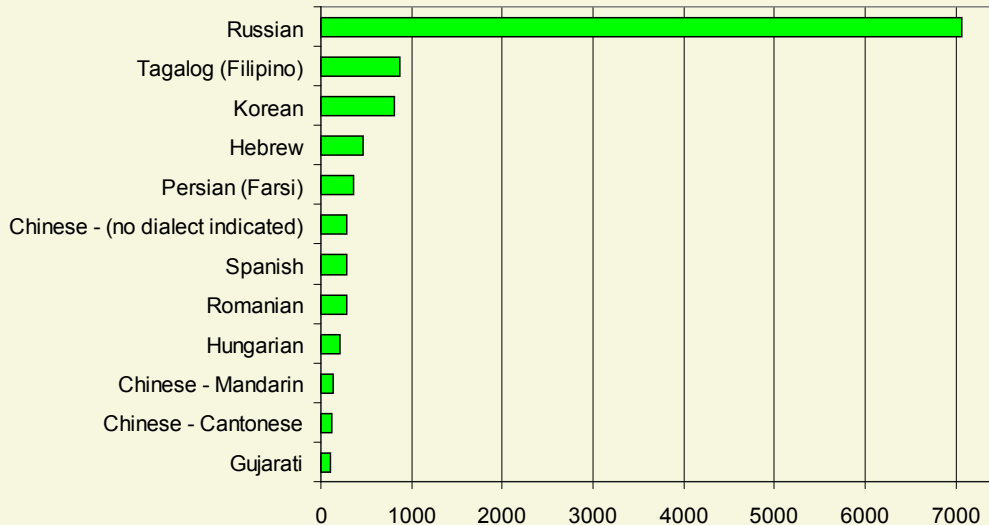

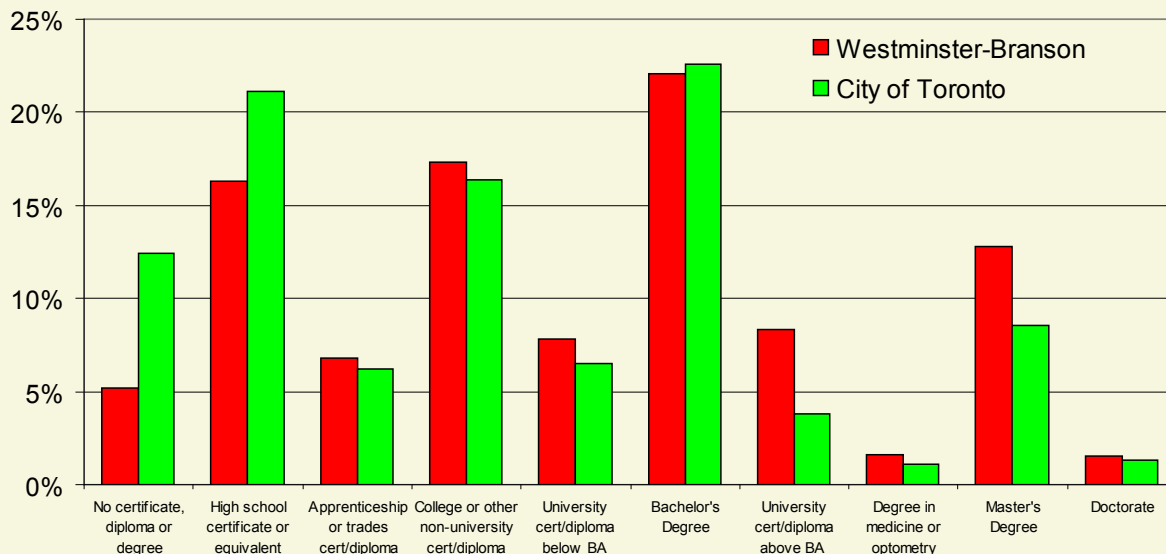

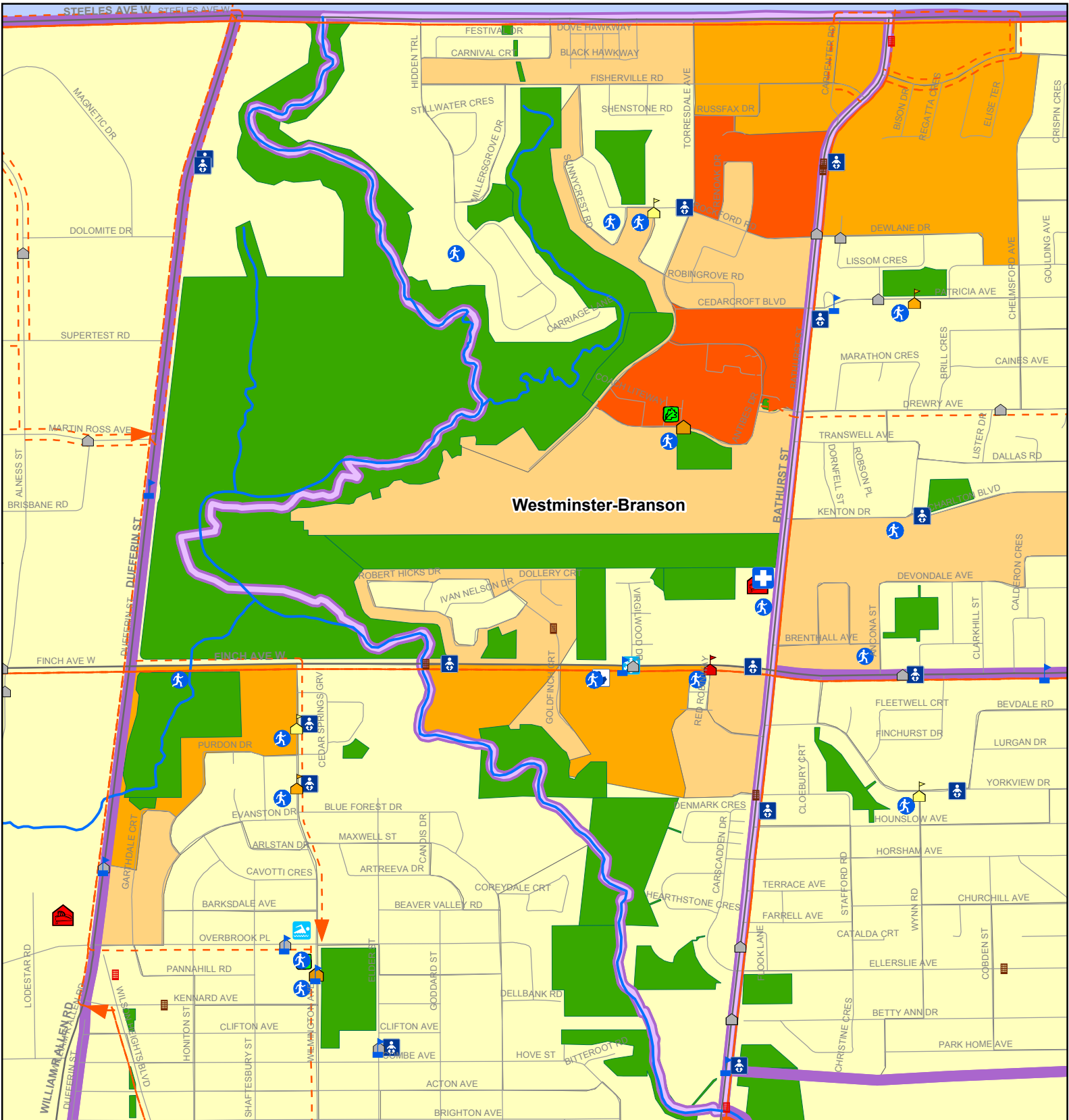
