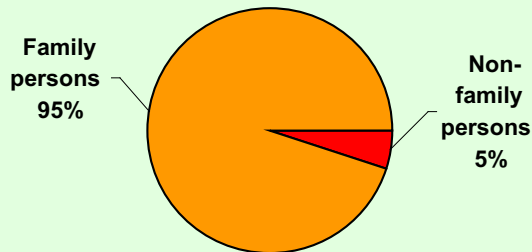

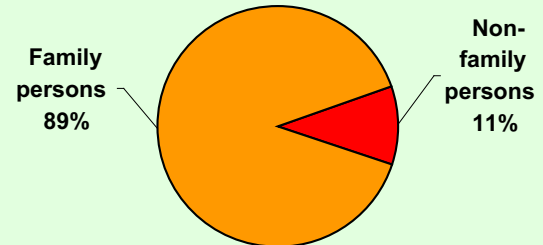

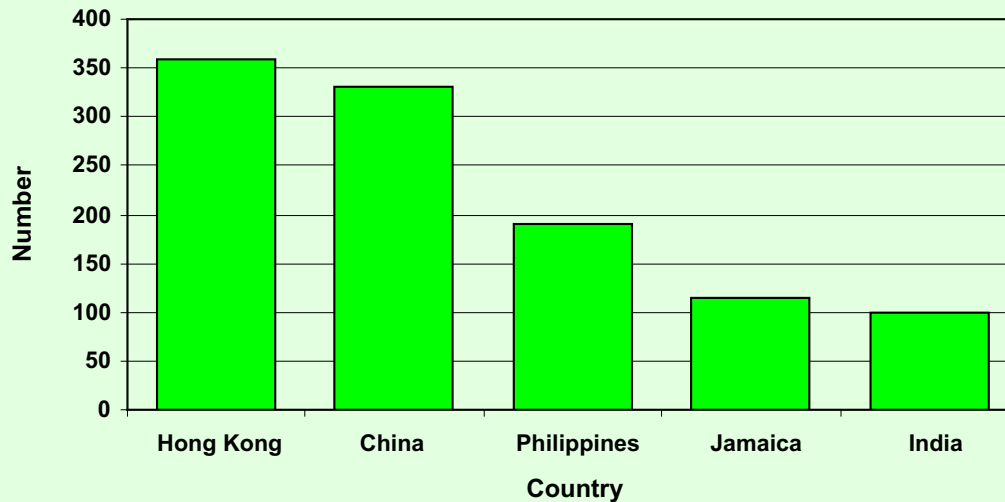


Living Arrangement  
Youth 20-24



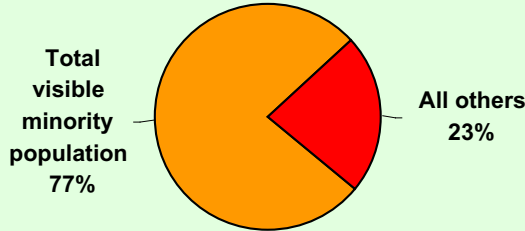

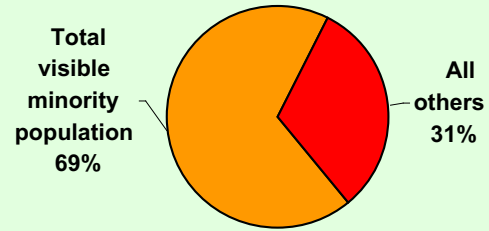

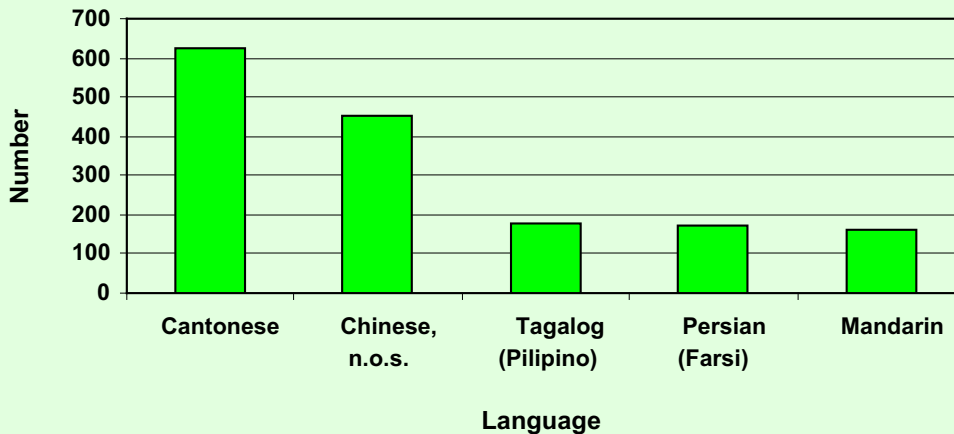


Visible Minority Characteristics  
Youth 20-24



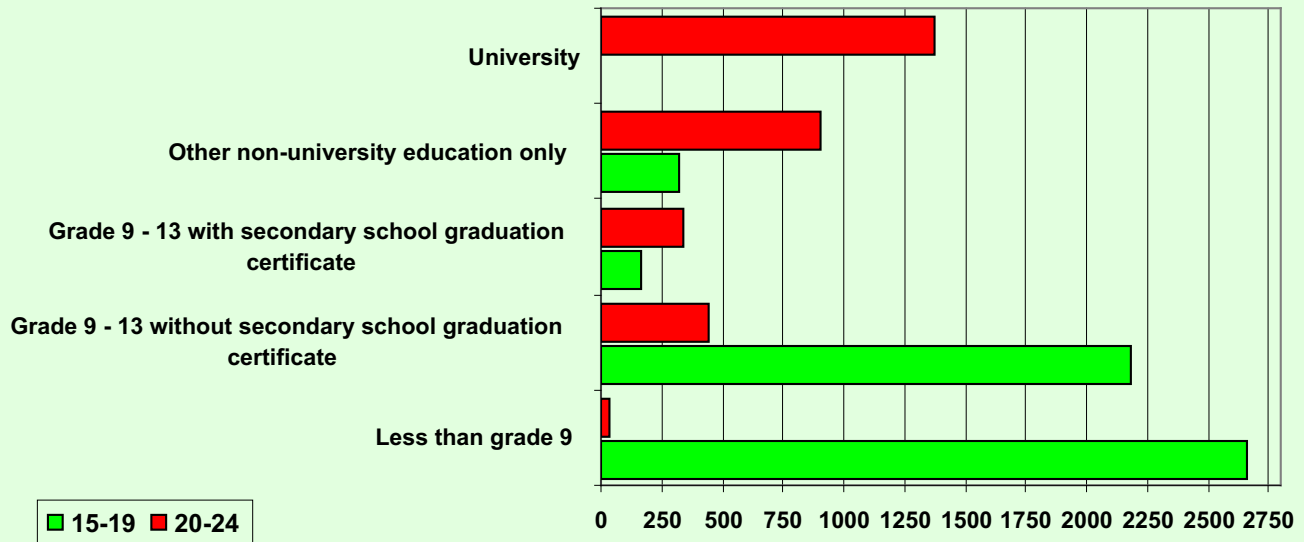
