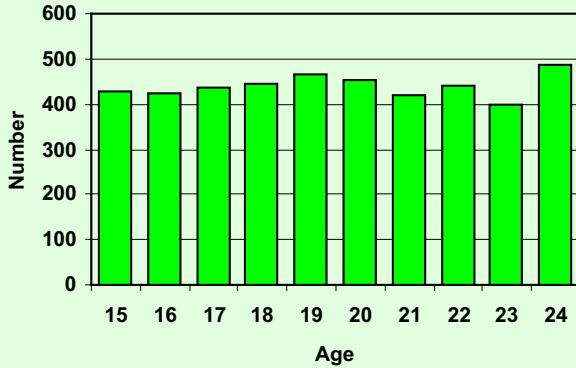

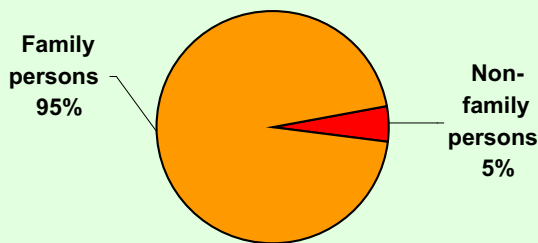

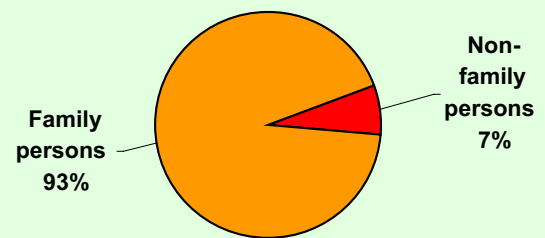

Living Arrangement Youth 15-19

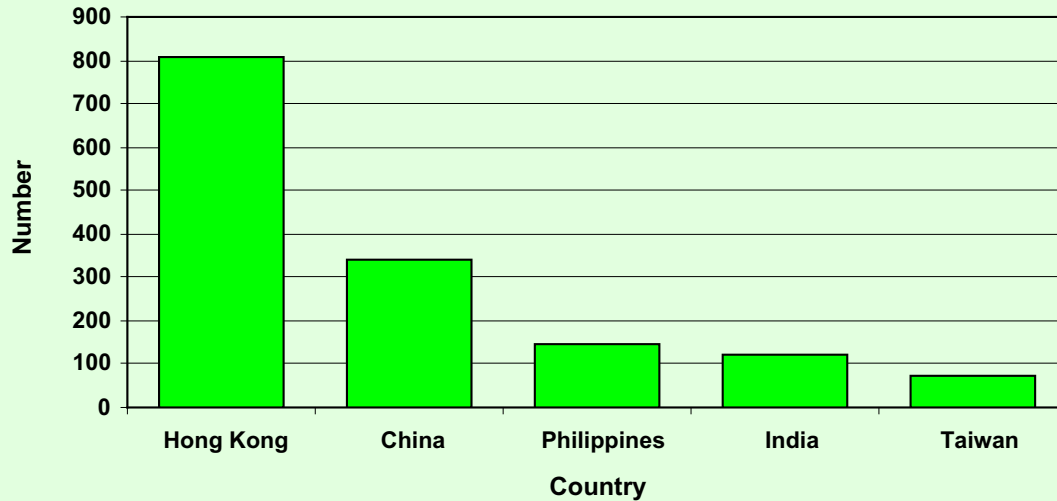


Living Arrangement Youth 20-24

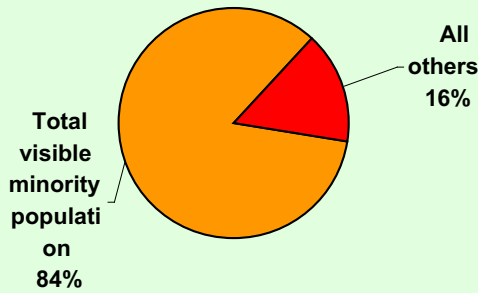
Immigrant Youth - Countries of Birth
Agincourt North, 2001



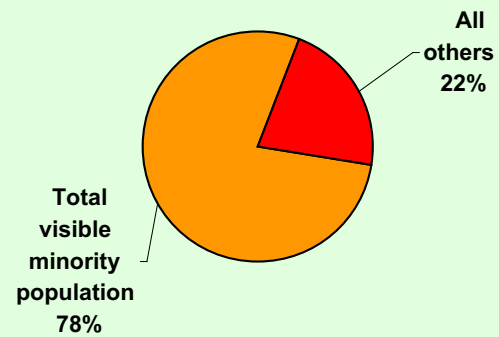

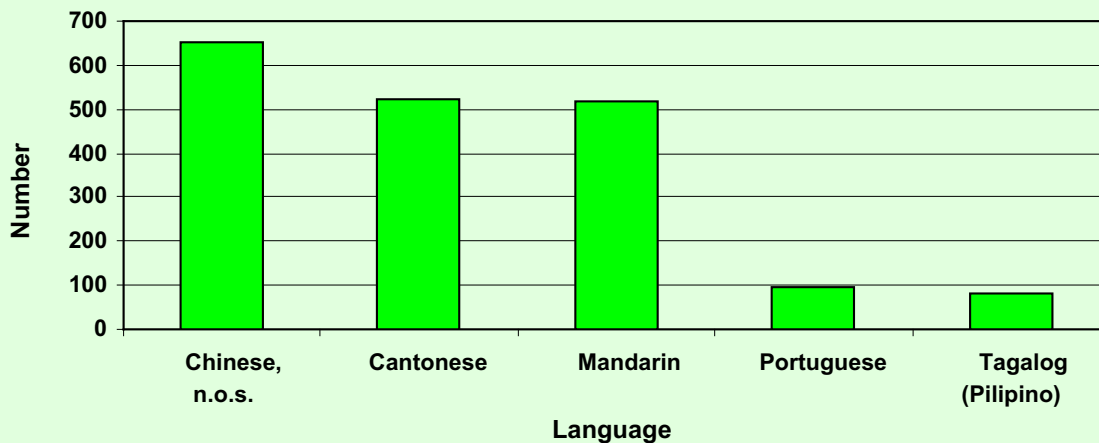


Visible Minority Characteristics
Youth 20-24



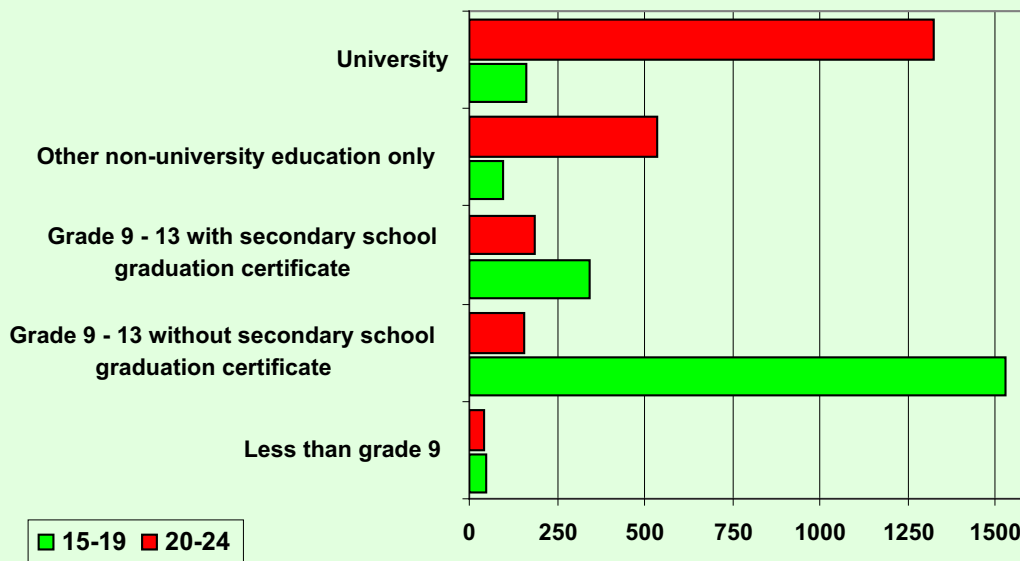

Agincourt North, 2001



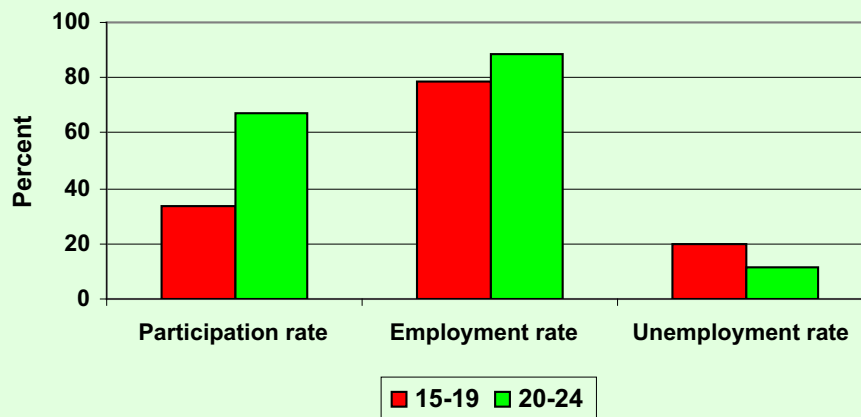
