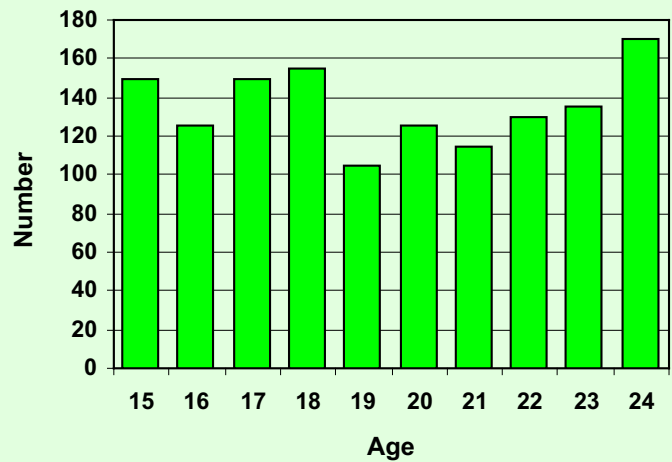

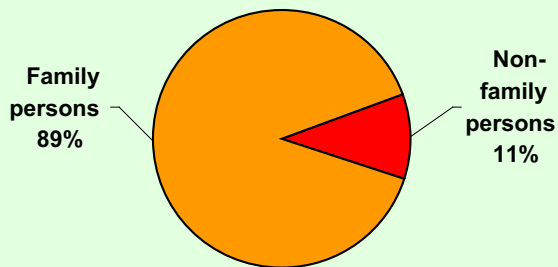

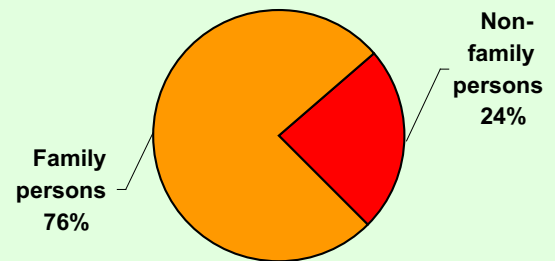

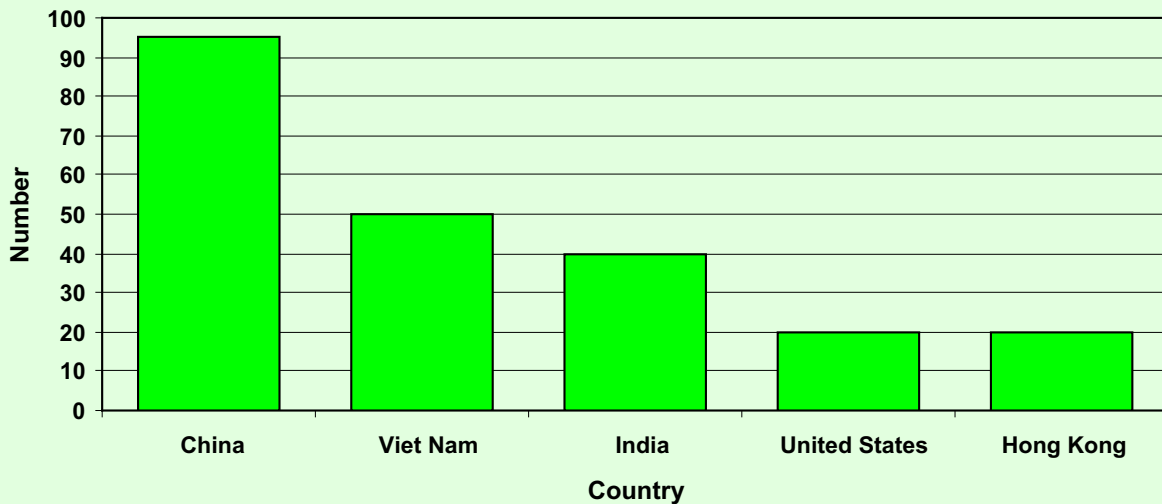


Living Arrangement
Youth 20-24



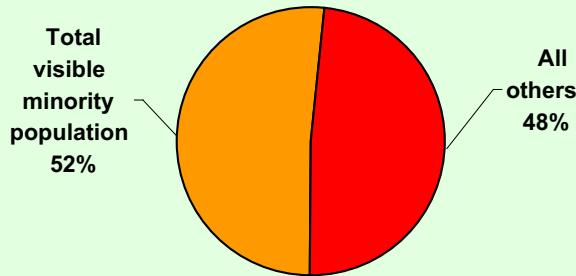

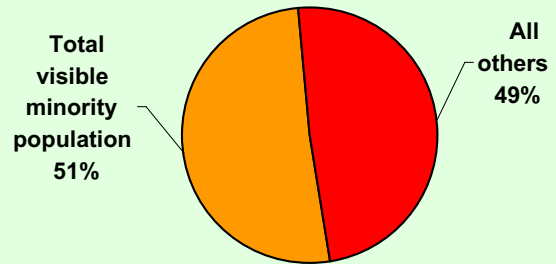

Visible Minority Characteristics Youth 15-19

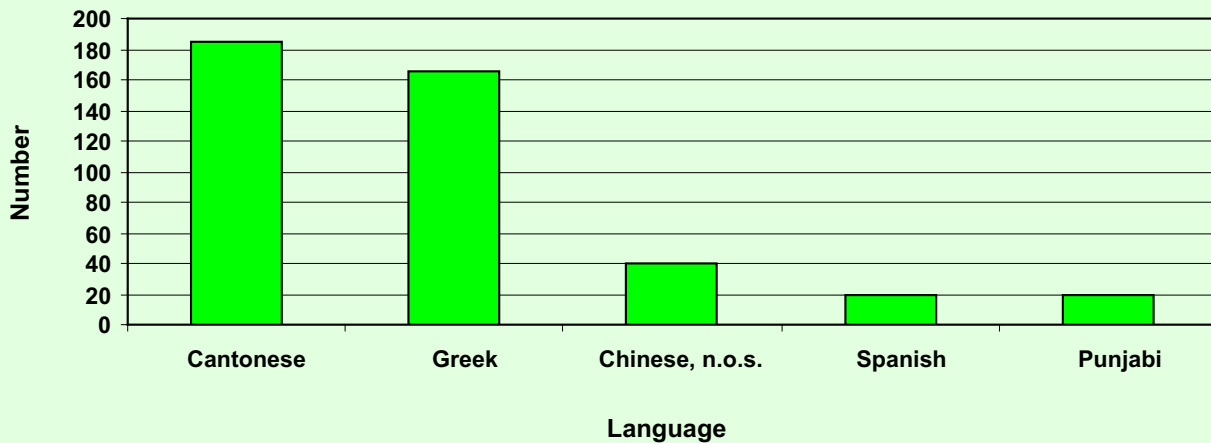


Visible Minority Characteristics Youth 20-24



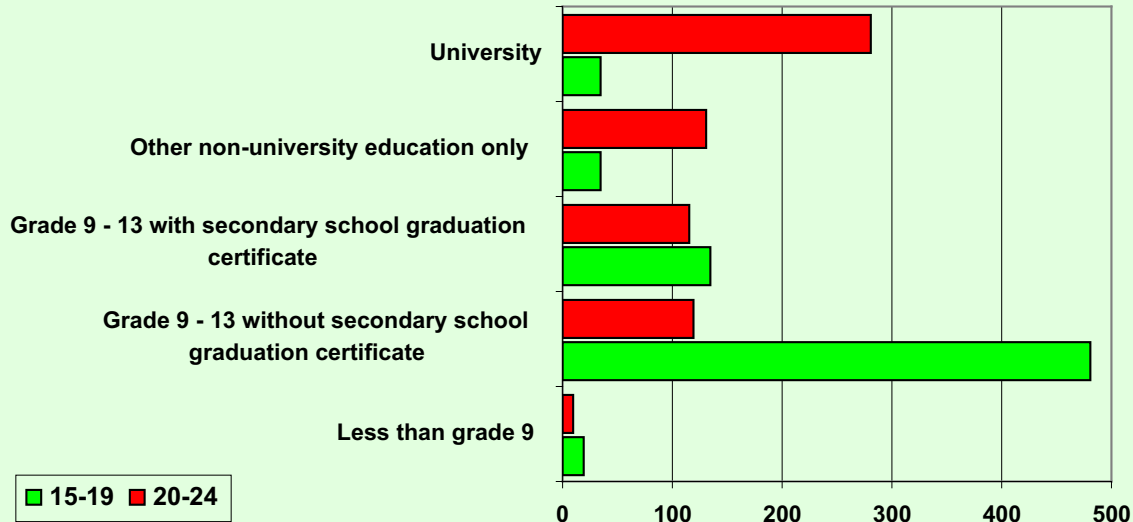

Non-Official Mother Tongues Blake-Jones, 2001



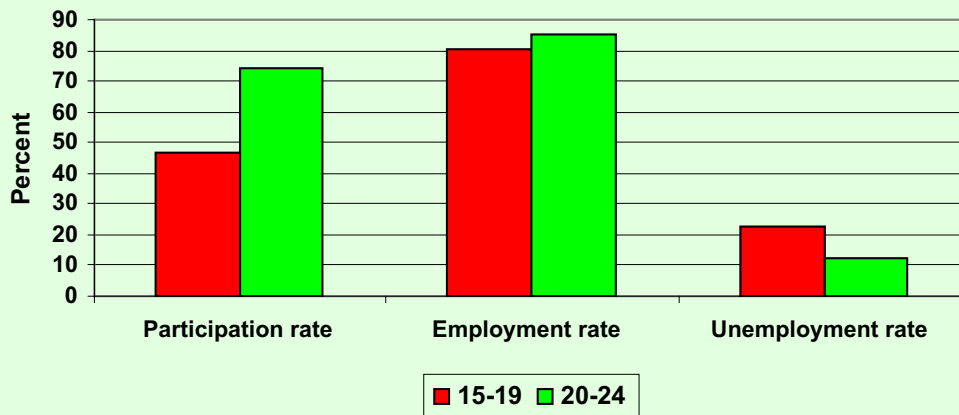
