

AFFIDAVIT OF ELECTION CANDIDATE

MAKE OATH AND SAY:

1. I was a candidate in the _____ Election.
2. I have paid the election sign deposit as required under 693-7A(1)(a) of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
3. I attest that, prior to the erection or display of election signs; I informed myself of the restrictions and requirements for the erection or display of election signs contained within Article II of Chapter 693 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
4. I did not erect or display the election signs identified and listed on the attached Schedule A to this affidavit as being erected or displayed contrary to Article II of Chapter 693 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
5. I have conferred with all of the people known to me who may have knowledge of the actions of persons acting on my behalf in relation to the erection or display of election signs, and based on my discussion with these individuals, I am informed and verily believe that to the best of my knowledge, no person acting on my behalf was responsible for erecting or displaying the election signs identified and listed on the attached Schedule A to this affidavit as being erected or displayed contrary to Article II of Chapter 693 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
6. The names, as well as the contact information and positions within my campaign, of the people whom I conferred to obtain information concerning the actions of persons acting on my behalf in relation to the erection or display of election signs are:

 - b. the principal purposes for which the City of Toronto intends to use this information; and,
 - c. the title, business address and business telephone number of a City of Toronto employee who can answer their questions about the collection of the aforementioned information.
9. I attest that I have provided the aforementioned individuals with a copy of the document attached as Appendix B to this affidavit; and obtained their consent prior to providing the information to the City of Toronto.
10. I make this affidavit in accordance with the provisions of Article II of Chapter 693 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code and for no improper purpose.

Consent and Notice of Collection for Election Sign Affidavit

This notice form is to be provided to people known to have knowledge of the actions of persons acting on behalf of the Candidate in relation to the erection or display of election signs.

Candidates for elected office operating a campaign in the City of Toronto, are subject to charges for the removal and storage of election signs placed in contravention of Article II Ch. 693 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code. The charges payable by a candidate may be waived under certain conditions. Please note that as a condition of a candidate obtaining a “waiver” of fees charged for removal and storage of election signs, the candidate must submit an affidavit stating that neither the candidate nor anyone acting on the candidate’s behalf was involved in the unlawful erection or display of election signs. The name and contact information of the individuals who inform the candidate of the actions of persons acting on behalf of the candidate must be listed on the affidavit to be returned to City of Toronto Municipal Licensing & Standards department.

As an individual with knowledge of the actions of persons acting on behalf of the candidate in relation to the erection or display of elections signs you are, upon receipt of this notice, providing consent for the inclusion of your name and contact information on the candidate’s affidavit.

The information is collected under the authority of Section 110 and paragraph 10 of section 8 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* as well as 693-10B(2) of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.

The collection of your personal information is required to ensure that legal requirements involving election sign postings are lawfully observed.
