

Voters' List Availability

The voters' list is available for candidates starting September 1, 2010.

Every candidate is provided with one free paper copy. Additional electronic or paper copies may be purchased from Toronto Election Services.

If an agent is picking up the list on behalf of a candidate, he or she must provide their personal identification, the *Voters' List Request* form, and an *Agent Appointment* form.

Nomination Day

Nomination Day is on September 10, 2010 (the last day to file, withdraw, or change a nomination for office). On this day nominations will only be accepted from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Toronto City Hall (100 Queen St. W., Toronto).

Campaigning on City Property

Please remember that **all** candidates are prohibited from campaigning on City property (i.e. community centres, city owned parks, etc...). For more information please refer to the "canvassing" section of your Candidate's Guide (pages 30 to 32).
