

# Electronic equipment collected and recycled



## Small electronics

Put small electronic items in the E-waste box provided by your building.

- Cell phones, home phones and accessories
- Computer cables and accessories
- Laptop computers and accessories
- Keyboards
- VCR/DVD players
- Hand-held computers
- Pagers
- Radios
- Cameras and video recorders



## Large electronics

Large electronics should be brought to the building's collection area.

- TVs
- Desktop computers and monitors
- Printers and scanners
- Copiers
- Typewriters
- Fax machines
- Stereos, tuners and turntables
- Receivers and speakers

**Protect your privacy.** Clear all personal information from computers, cell phones and electronics prior to collection/drop-off/donation (wipe your drives/clear your SIM cards). **VHS tapes, CDs and DVDs do not go in recycling.** Some electronics stores have e-recycling programs that accept batteries, CDs, DVDs, etc. If there is no other option, put these in your garbage, except batteries which are household hazardous waste and must be taken to a Drop-off Depot.
