

## Smoke-Free Ontario Act

The **Smoke-Free Ontario Act** is intended to reduce the number of children and teens who start smoking and to protect Ontarians from second-hand smoke.

Did you know?

- Smoking by students, staff or visitors is prohibited anywhere on school property including the parking lot, playing fields, and playgrounds
- This law is in effect 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
- Smoking/holding lighted tobacco anywhere on school property could cost you \$305
- Giving or sharing a cigarette with anyone under age 19 could cost you \$365
