Please note the following requirements of a DSR:

- (1) Is fully enclosed, and is not a washroom, a waiting area, a transaction counter or wicket at a racetrack, or an area used for public transportation.
- (2) Has a capacity of not more than 25% of the occupancy load.
- (3) Is equipped with a separate ventilation system that maintains a minimum ventilation rate of 30 litres per second per person, based on the maximum occupancy load that is ventilated directly to the outside air and exhausted at a rate of at least 110% of supply. Such exhaust must be no less than three metres from any intake or opening.
- (4) Size approval is required by Toronto Public Health prior to permit application to Urban Development Services. (is not greater in size than 25% of occupiable public space for public places; 25% of occupiable space for workplace; and 50% of occupiable public space for bingo halls)
- (5) Once DSR is installed a "Health Warning" sign must be posted at all entrances.
- (6) Smoking is not permitted outside of the DSR.
