

ROUNDTABLE FORUM – MAY 1, 2002

City Council on May 30, 31, and June 1, 2001 requested the Medical Officer of Health to convene a roundtable comprising City departments and divisions, together with provincial and federal partners and members of the Toronto Cancer Prevention Coalition to determine the means, timetable, roles, responsibilities, capacities and resources for phasing in the proposed Implementation Frameworks, and report the results of this roundtable to City Council through Board of Health.

The Roundtable Forum “*From Planning to Action*” a collaboration of Toronto Cancer Prevention Coalition and Toronto Public Health, was held on Wednesday May 1, 2002 from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. at Metro Hall, Toronto. A total of 5 roundtables were convened as follows:

- **Alcohol**
- **Dietary Risk Factors**
- **Occupational and Environmental Carcinogens**
- **Physical Activity and Tobacco**
- **Ultraviolet Radiation**

The Medical Officer of Health invited key representatives from City department and divisions as identified by the working groups of the Toronto Cancer Prevention Coalition, along with key representatives from external agencies and organizations to participate in moving forward the collaborative implementation plan for cancer prevention. A total of 140 participants were in attendance comprising of 68 City staff and 72 external partners to include provincial and federal partners.
