

No. 420-85. A BY-LAW

To designate Fort York and the Garrison Common
as a heritage conservation district.

(Passed May 21, 1985.)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Toronto enacts as follows: —

1. The area within the heavy lines shown on the map attached to and forming part of this by-law, is hereby designated as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.
2. This By-law does not come into force without the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.

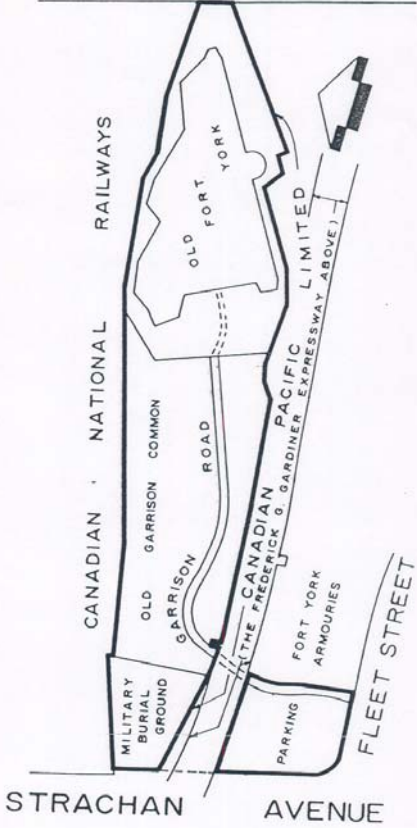
