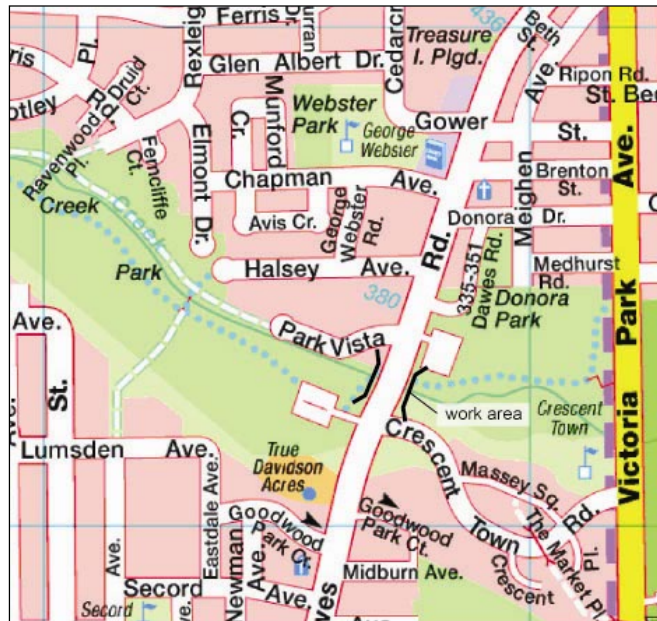
Dawes Road Bridge over Massey Creek Structure Rehabilitation

Anticipated Project Start Date: May 9, 2011
Expected Project Completion Date: Mid October 2011

The City of Toronto will be rehabilitating the Dawes Road Bridge over Massey Creek in order to ensure the structural integrity of the structure to prolong its life. This work is being carried out as part of a bridge maintenance and improvement program.

A map showing the work area is included below. Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and will be appreciated.

Construction Details

The project will involve reconstruction of the bridge deck, sidewalks, and parapet walls. New railings will be installed, expansion joints will be eliminated and repairs will be made to the underside of the bridge.

The work will be done in two stages:

- **Stage 1** will involve work on the **west half** of the bridge with traffic movement on the east side (**May 2011 – July 2011**)

- **Stage 2** will begin upon completion of Stage 1. It will involve work on the **east half** of the bridge with traffic transferred to the west side (**August 2011 – October 2011**) You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or work to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. These include:

- Vehicle and pedestrian traffic will be restricted according to construction details listed above.
- Advance traffic warning signs will be posted in the area to advise the public of traffic restrictions and pedestrian crossings.
- Access to the neighbouring homes, Taylor Massey Creek Trail, and the park will not be affected by this construction.

The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

TTC Service Changes

Bus service will not be interrupted during construction; however, bus stops in the vicinity of the bridge will be temporarily relocated.
