Intersection Realignment and Traffic Signal Installation on Yonge Street and Roxborough Street East and West

Expected Project Start Date: July 2011
Expected Completion Date: September 2011

The City of Toronto will be realigning the intersection and installing traffic signals on Yonge Street at Roxborough Street in order to improve traffic and pedestrian safety and operations. This project is a component of the planned 2011 Capital Works Program.

This work will take place on Yonge Street at Roxborough Street East and Roxborough Street West.

A map showing the work area is included below.

Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and will be appreciated.

Map of Work Area

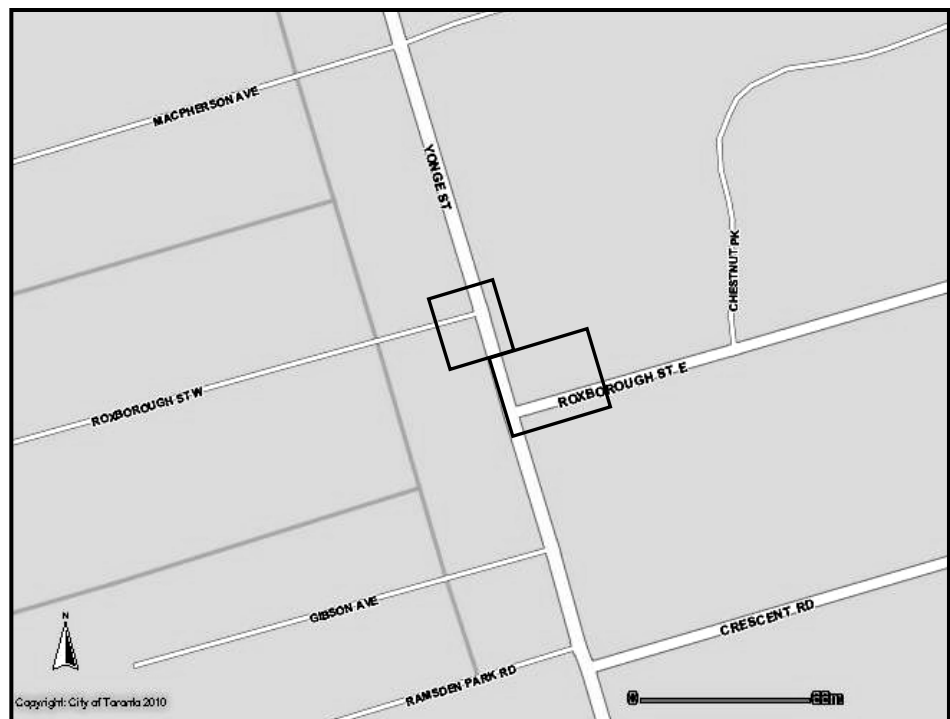
Construction Details

Yonge Street and Roxborough Street East

Traffic island, road, curb and sidewalk on the northeast corner of will be removed and realigned to remove the right turn lane.

Street light poles will be relocated as required to match the proposed curb alignment.

Curb, sidewalk and road will be reconstructed.



Landscaping, including the installation of trees, plantings, lighting will be completed within the designated planting area within the sidewalk.

Yonge Street and Roxborough Street West

Curb and sidewalk will be removed to accommodate the installation of traffic signal pole bases.

Pole bases will be constructed and curb and sidewalk will be restored.

Traffic signals will be installed; setup and operation of the traffic signals will begin.

You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or work to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

Parking Restrictions & Allowances

Construction will require temporary closure of private driveways. Where the property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Further notice will be given prior to the temporary closure.
