North Bound Allen Road Ramp at Eglinton Avenue West Intersection Improvements and Sidewalk reconstruction

Expected Project Start Date: October 6, 2011

Expected Project Completion Date: November 4, 2011

The City of Toronto's 2011 Capital Construction Programme includes the improvement of the intersection at North Bound Allen Road Ramp at Eglinton West Avenue. The main scope of work consist of the realignment of the curb and sidewalk and the construction of an additional lane on the west side of the ramp from Eglinton Avenue up to 150 m along the ramp.

Construction Details

- This work is being undertaken by Sanscon Construction Limited.
- Construction is scheduled to start in the October 6, 2011, provided that the contractor obtains all the necessary underground utility stake out.
- Weather permitting, the construction is scheduled to be completed by November 4, 2011.
- Business and emergency access will be maintained.
- Safe pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Access and storage for trucks and heavy equipment will be managed in such a way so there is no obstruction to private driveways and sidewalks.

Parking Restrictions and General Information

- Traffic will be opened at least one lane in each direction, except for a period of two weeks when the left turning lane onto North bound Allen Road ramp will be prohibited for safety reason. Advance notice will be posted to warn motorist of the prohibition.
- Please expect traffic delays during construction and drive with caution in the construction zone.

Every effort will be made to complete this essential work as quickly as possible and with the least inconvenience to the community. Your assistance and co-operation during the construction period is crucial and appreciated.

Work Hours

Normal working hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. However, the Contractor is permitted to work within the City's bylaw requirements and shall work on weekends and 24 hours shift to complete the work as soon as possible in order to cause the least inconvenience to the public.
