

Construction Details

Work will include the replacement of sanitary sewer, storm sewer, sewer services to property line, watermain and sub-standard water services to property line.

You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or work to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. These include restriction of traffic to one lane in each direction. The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and cooperation.

Water Service

Temporary disruption to your water supply may occur as your service is switched from the old watermain to the new watermain. Further notice will be given prior to any scheduled disruption.

Sub-standard water service lines (lead, galvanized steel, services less than 19mm diameter) from the watermain to the property line will be replaced as part of this work. This construction does not include the replacement of the private side of the water service connection – the portion of the pipe running from the property line to the water meter (please see the figure for an illustration). The

property owner may wish to hire their own contractor or the City's contractor to replace the private side of the connection.

Parking Restrictions & Allowances

There will be no parking allowed on Burnhamthorpe Road through the construction areas. Construction will require temporary closure of private driveways. Where the property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Further notice will be given prior to the temporary closure.

Boulevard Work

Work within boulevards on both the north and south side will include installation of sewer services and water services up to the property line.

Property owners in the affected area are reminded to remove any privately owned items from the boulevard. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.
