Bridge Rehabilitation Leslie Street Bridge over German Mills Creek

Expected Project Start Date: July 4, 2011
Expected Project Completion Date: late November, 2011

The City of Toronto will be carrying out bridge rehabilitation works on the Leslie Street Bridge over German Mills Creek, located approximately 250 metres south of Steeles Avenue on Leslie Street. A map of the work area is shown below. This bridge requires rehabilitation work in order to extend its service life so that the bridge remains safe for the pedestrian and vehicular traffic in the future years.

There will be lane restrictions at the bridge location while the work is being carried out. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction. One sidewalk on the bridge also will be closed for pedestrian.

Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is appreciated.
