The City of Toronto, Technical Services, Design & Construction - Linear Infrastructure will be replacing the watermain on the east-side of Victoria Park Avenue from Kingston Road to 40m north of Winston Avenue. This project is part of the Toronto Water Watermain Replacement Program.

A map showing the work area is included below. Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and will be appreciated.

Construction Details

The expected start date of construction will begin in mid- April, 2011 and last until mid-July, 2011, commencing from Kingston Road and will proceed north to Winston Avenue.

The replacement of the watermain will be on the east-side of Victoria Park Avenue **only** (Ward 36). The replacement and reconnection of water services, as required, includes properties on both sides of Victoria Park Avenue (Ward 32 and Ward 36). General excavation, sidewalk, curb, road, boulevard and pavement replacement/restoration, required to facilitate the scope of work will be completed as required. There will be

temporary lane closures and parking restrictions adjacent to construction zones, as required. Local access and emergency traffic will be maintained at all times. You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule and/or work to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work between Kingston Road and Meadow Avenue will take place after hours, from 7:00p.m. to 7:00 a.m. All other work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

TTC Service Changes

All transit routes along Victoria Park Avenue and Kingston Road will remain as per existing operations.

Parking restrictions/allowances

Construction will require temporary closure of private driveways. Where the property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Further notice will be given prior to the temporary closure.

Boulevard Work

Work in the boulevard in front of homes is expected due to the watermain replacement and upgrade of water services. Property owners in the affected area are reminded to remove any privately owned items from the boulevard. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.
