UPDATE Chillery Avenue and Strode Drive Local Road Reconstruction

Revised Project Start Date: October 17, 2011
Expected Completion Date: December 9, 2011

You previously received a Construction Notice about this project, dated October 3, 2010. Please note the following **revised** start and completion dates for the project.

The City of Toronto, Technical Services, Design & Construction – Linear Infrastructure will be:

- Installing a sidewalk on the south-side of Chillery Avenue and north and west-side of Strode Drive;
- Reconstructing the pavement structure, replacement of curb, boulevard and driveway restoration, and sod replacement as required, for Chillery Avenue (Brimley Road to East limit) and Strode Drive (Brimley Road to Chillery Avenue); and
- Replacing all undersized waterservices from the property line to the watermain along Chillery Avenue and Strode Drive.

This project is part of the 2011 Transportation Capital Works and Toronto Water Program.

This work will take place on Chillery Avenue and Strode Drive. Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and will be appreciated.

Construction Details

The expected start date of construction will begin in October 2011, and last until the beginning of December 2011, commencing from Brimley Road and will proceed east along both Chillery Avenue and Strode Drive.

During construction, temporary lane closures adjacent to construction zones will be enforced, as required. Business access and emergency traffic will be maintained at all times. You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or work to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

TTC Service Changes

Transit routes along Brimley Road will be maintained with no changes.

Parking restrictions/allowances

Construction will require temporary closure of private driveways. Where the property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Further notice will be given prior to the temporary closure.

Boulevard Work

Work in the boulevard in front of homes is expected due to the undersized waterservice replacements and sidewalk installation. Property owners in the affected area are reminded to remove any privately owned items from the boulevard, including sprinkler systems and lines. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.
