Laneway 28.7 m south of Dundas Street West from Indian Road Crescent to 55.8 m east of Indian Road Crescent, Laneway 33.5 m south of Dundas St. West from 54.9 m east of Parkway Avenue to Parkway Avenue, Laneway 35.4 m south of Constance Street from 36.6 m east of Sunnyside Avenue to 36.6 m west of Roncesvalles Road, Laneway 36.6 m east of Sunnyside Avenue from 35.5 m south of Constance Street to Constance Street, Laneway 36.6 m west of Roncesvalles Avenue from Grenadier Road to Constance Street, Laneway 36.6 m west of Tyndall Avenue from 54.9 m south of Springhurst Avenue to Springhurst Avenue, Laneway 30.5 m north of Wallace Avenue from Lansdowne Avenue to St. Clarens Avenue, Laneway 30.5 m south of Lappin Avenue from St. Clarens Avenue to Lansdowne Avenue, Laneway 36.6 m west of St. Clarens Avenue from 30.5 m north of Wallace Avenue to 30.5 m south of Lappin Avenue, Laneway 36.6 m west of Emerson Avenue from 30.5 m north of Lappin Avenue to 30.5 m south of Dupont Street, Laneway 30.5 m north of Lappin Avenue from St. Clarens Avenue to Lansdowne Avenue, Laneway 54.90 m east of Parkway Avenue from 40.20 m north of Grenadier Road to 33.5 m south of Dundas St. West, Laneway 43.7 m north of Dundas Street West from Coolmine Road to Dovercourt Road.

The City's 2011 Capital Reconstruction Program includes the reconstruction of drain and pavement on the Lanes as described above. **DOMTI LTD** will be the Contractor for this project.

- Weather permitting the lane construction will commence by the middle of October, 2011. It will take about one to two weeks to complete one lane and Contractor may work at more than one location in a given time. Access and storage for trucks and heavy equipment will be managed in such a way so that there will be no obstruction to private driveways and sidewalks.

Parking Restrictions and General Information

- During the construction, the lane will be closed and affected residents are asked to park on adjacent side streets where it is permitted.
- Residents should not park their vehicles where on-street parking is strictly prohibited such as in a zone designated as No Parking Anytime, restricted time of day for rush hour routes, snow routes, diamond lanes, etc.
- Construction signs will be posted **24 hours** before the start of construction activities in order to inform residents of the parking and access restrictions.
- Temporary on-street parking permits may be obtained by residents. Please contact the Municipal Inspector listed below to receive one.

Every effort will be made to complete this essential work as quickly as possible and with the least inconvenience to the community. Your assistance and co-operation during the construction period is crucial and appreciated.

Work Hours

Normal working hours are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. However, the Contractor may wish to work later than 7 p.m. or on Saturdays and Sundays within the City's by-law requirements.
