Road Resurfacing and Sidewalk Reconstruction

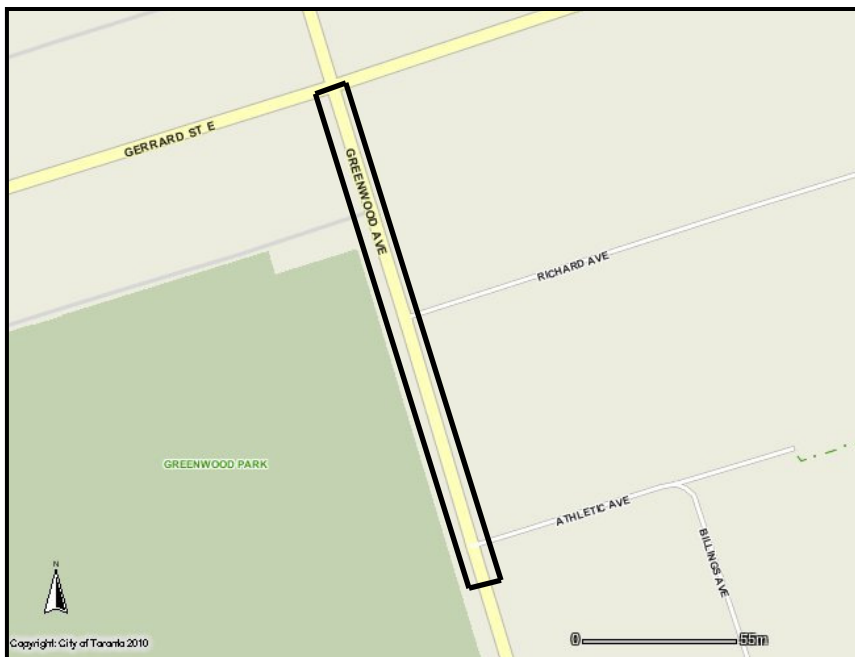
Expected Project Start Date: Week of October 24, 2011
Expected Completion Date: Week of November 28, 2011

The City of Toronto will be resurfacing the road and reconstructing deficient sidewalk in order to improve traffic and pedestrian safety and operations. This project is part of the 2011 Capital Works Program.

This work will take place on Greenwood Avenue from Gerrard Street East to Athletic Avenue.

Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and appreciated.

Construction Details

Deficient areas of sidewalk will be identified, removed and replaced.

Top layer of the existing road pavement will be milled in order to place a layer of new asphalt.

The existing road base will be inspected and deficient areas will be identified, removed and repaired.

A new surface layer of asphalt will be placed to match the existing road configuration.

Pavement markings will be completed and restoration of any disturbed areas will be completed.

You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or work to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

Parking Restrictions & Allowances

Construction will require temporary closure of private driveways. Where the property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Further notice will be given prior to the temporary closure. In addition to the above, on-street parking will be restricted within the work area.
