Humber College Boulevard Highway 27 to Finch Avenue and Finch Avenue to Carrier Drive Road Rehabilitation

Traffic Restriction in Intersection of Humber College Boulevard and Humberline Drive

The City of Toronto is currently undertaking road rehabilitation on Humber College Boulevard from Highway 27 to Finch Avenue and from Finch Avenue to Carrier Drive.

In order to undertake road repair safely in the intersection of Humber College Boulevard and Humberline Drive, some traffic restrictions through the intersection will be required for approximately five days, starting on July 4, 2011 and extending to approximately July 8, 2011.

The traffic restrictions in the intersection will result in the following:

- There will be no access to Humberline Drive from Humber College Boulevard, i.e., both northbound and southbound traffic on Humber College Boulevard will be prohibited from turning onto Humberline Drive.
- Entry to Humberline Drive will be off Finch Avenue.
- Access will be maintained for traffic on Humberline Drive turning onto Humber College Boulevard.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Humber College Boulevard.
- TTC service on Humberline Drive will be maintained in the eastbound direction.
