Restoration of Massey Creek within Warden Woods Park

Expected Project Start Date: July 18, 2011
Expected Completion Date: December 31, 2011

The City of Toronto will be undertaking restoration of Massey Creek within Warden Woods Park in order to **protect exposed Sanitary Trunk Sewer** crossing the creek. This project is part of the Toronto City Council-approved 2011 Capital Works Program.

This work will take place within Warden Woods Park. A map showing the work area is included below.

Construction Details

The restoration works will involve:

1. Restoration of creek bed (riffle and pool structure with field stones)
2. Restoration of creek bank (Armour stone walls with brush layering)
3. Planting

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
