## **BROWNFIELD GARDENS AND BRYCEMOOR ROAD LOCAL ROAD RECONSTRUCTION SEWER AND WATERMAIN CONSTRUCTION SCARBOROUGH DISTRICT**

**Expected Project Start Date: October 3, 2011  
Expected Completion Date: July 31, 2012**

The City of Toronto will be reconstructing Brownfield Gardens and Brycemoor Road including sewer and watermain construction to improve the overall roadway and drainage conditions. This project is part of the 2011 Transportation Services and Toronto Water Capital Works Program.

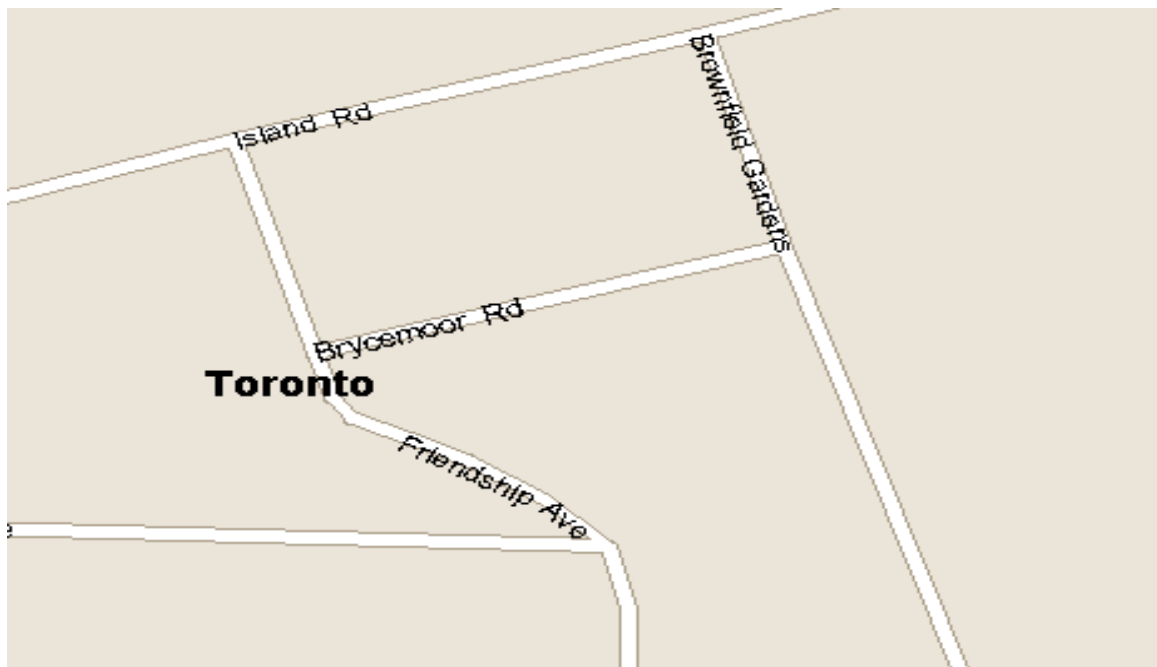
This work will take place as follow:

1. Brownfield Gardens local road reconstruction - From Island Road to the South Limit
2. Brycemoor Road local road reconstruction - From Friendship Avenue to Brownfield Gardens

### **Construction Details**

#### Brownfield Gardens:

1. Road Reconstruction
2. Storm Sewer Construction
3. Water Service Replacement

#### Brycemoor Road:

4. Road Reconstruction
5. Storm Sewer Construction
6. Sanitary Sewer Construction
7. Sanitary Service Connection
8. Watermain Replacement
9. Water service Replacement

You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or work to be undertaken.

## Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

## Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. These include:

- Vehicle and pedestrian traffic will be restricted according to construction details listed above.

The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

## TTC Service Changes

Bus service will not be interrupted during construction.

## Parking Restrictions & Allowances

Construction may require temporary closure of driveways. Further notice will be given prior to the temporary closure.

## Boulevard Work

There are planted landscaping, fences, irrigation systems or other physical features in front of the residential properties which are within the City property limits. These may be in the way of the construction. In such cases, residents are advised to remove these items prior to the beginning of construction in order to avoid unnecessary damage. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items installed on the City's property.

Due to the road urbanization (from ditches to curb and gutter), the proposed driveway width will be revised according to the City's Standard.
