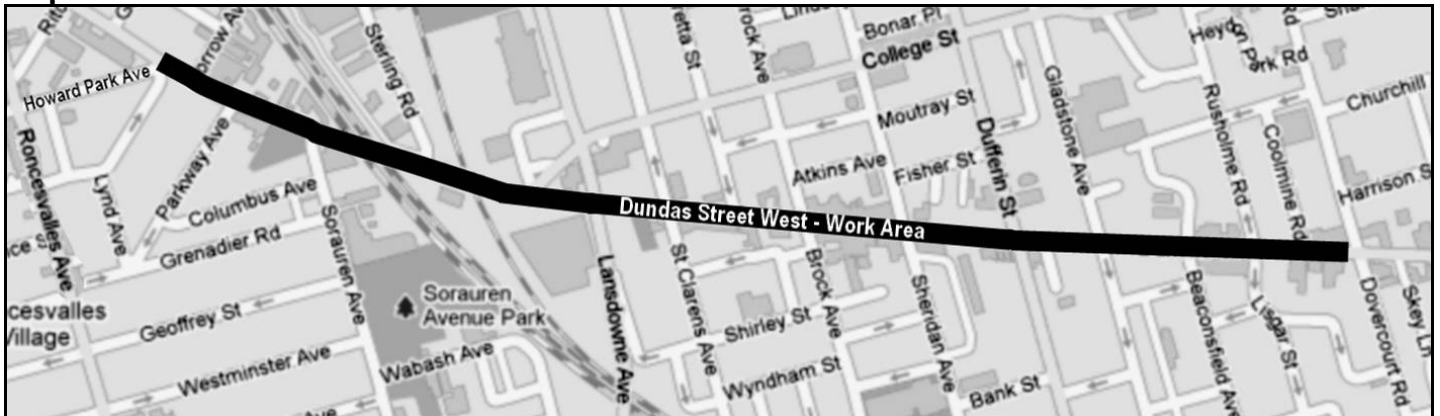
## Dundas Street West Roadway and Sidewalk Construction

**Project Start Date: May 16 2011\***  
**Expected Completion Date: October 2011\***

*\*Timelines subject to change due to unforeseen events.*

The City of Toronto will be doing major construction work to improve Dundas Street West from just east of Howard Park Avenue to just west of Dovercourt Road. (There is also similar construction in progress east of Dovercourt Road.)

### Construction Details

The work will involve reconstruction and resurfacing of road, reconstruction of curb and sidewalk, partial traffic signals, partial electrical work, and partial streetscape (e.g. trees, signs, benches and shelters). This work will be divided into two sections:

#### **Section 1: Lansdowne Avenue to Dovercourt Road**

Major construction will be from May 16 to mid-September, 2011, starting at Lansdowne Avenue going east toward Dovercourt Road. The work will be staged, starting on the north sidewalk, then westbound lanes, then south sidewalk, and then eastbound lanes.

#### **Section 2: Howard Park Avenue to Lansdowne Avenue**

All major construction will be carried out from early September to October of 2011. Staging is to be determined.

Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and will be appreciated.

### Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

### Traffic Restrictions

During road and sidewalk reconstruction, traffic on Dundas Street West from Howard Park Avenue to Dovercourt Road will be limited to one lane in each direction.

### Parking Restrictions

Construction will require temporary closure of private driveways. Where a property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Notice will be given prior to each temporary closure.

No parking will be permitted in the active work zones.

The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

## Intersection Closures

The following intersections will be closed for limited periods to allow for full road reconstruction. Advisory signs and/or notices will be distributed accordingly before each specific closure. Dates are to be determined.

## Continued Pedestrian Access

Pedestrian access to businesses, residences and walkways will be maintained on both sides of all roads at all times during construction.

## Deliveries

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone may need to be coordinated with the on-site City inspector. See project contacts below.

## Private Street Furniture

***All private street furniture (e.g. fencing, plants, storage materials) located on City property (e.g. next to the sidewalk) must be removed prior to May 16, 2011.***

## Recycling and Garbage Collection

Follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will temporarily move bins to an appropriate location and return them promptly. Please label your bins with your address.

## TTC Transit Service Route Changes

505 DUNDAS streetcars are currently being diverted in both directions starting at College Street east to Spadina Avenue. This diversion is to accommodate ongoing road work on Dundas Street West east of Dovercourt Avenue and will remain in place until further notice.

A 505 DUNDAS replacement bus service is operating on Dundas Street between Dundas West Station and Spadina Avenue.
