Dry Pond Facility in Moore Park – Temporary Road Closures on Peckham Avenue and Cactus Avenue

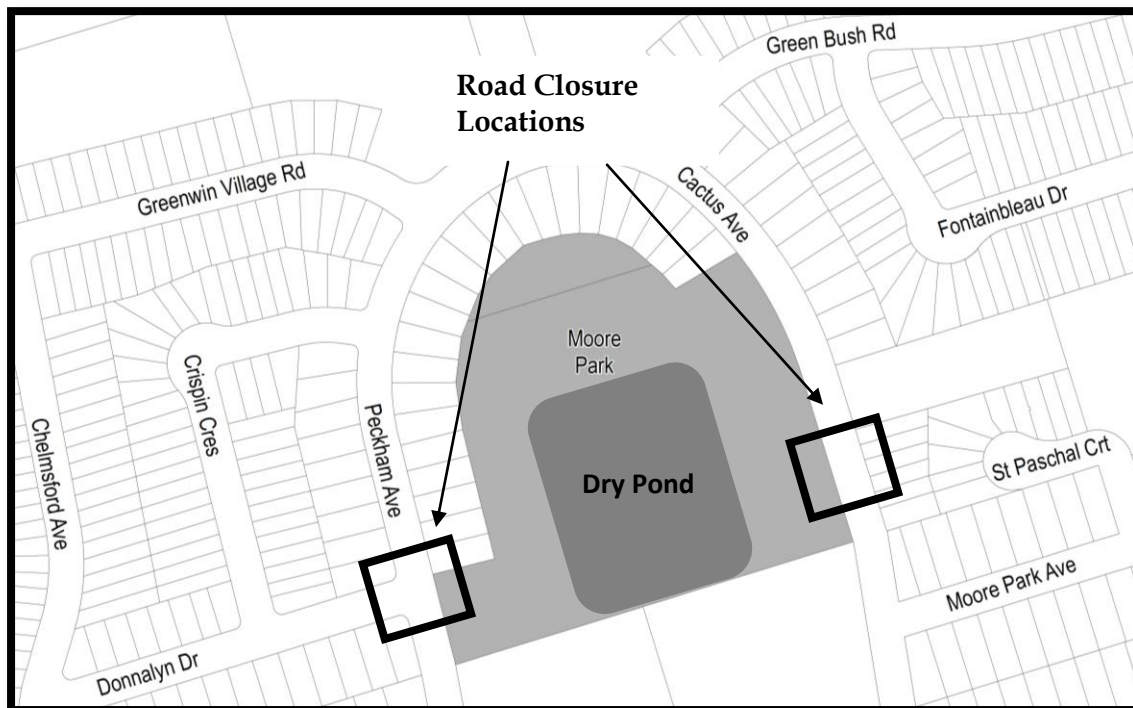
As part of the City of Toronto's Basement Flooding Protection Program, a dry pond will be constructed in Moore Park to help relieve surface flooding in the area. The construction of the storm dry pond will take place in the central portion of the park, outside of the tennis court and playground area. Construction work will also take place at the intersections of Peckham Avenue and Donnalyn Drive and on Cactus Avenue, requiring temporary road closures at these locations. A map showing the location of the road closures is provided below. Your co-operation and patience during construction is appreciated.

Road Closure Details

New inlet and outlet structures will be installed on Cactus Avenue (north of Moore Park Avenue) and on Peckham Avenue (at Donnalyn Drive), which will require temporary road closures to complete the sewer works, on the following dates:

- Cactus Avenue (north of Moore Park Avenue) - May 23 to June 3, 2011
- Peckham Avenue and Donnalyn Drive – June 6 to June 18, 2011

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be some temporary inconveniences to the local community. All efforts will be made to minimize any disruption to the local community. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. These restrictions include:

Pedestrian and Vehicle Traffic

- Pedestrian and vehicle traffic will be disrupted at the road closure locations on the dates specified. Signs will be posted to advise of detours and pedestrian crossings.
- Emergency (police, fire and medical response) access will be maintained at all times.
- Recycling and garbage collection will not be affected. Please follow your normal routine. Alternative locations for garbage collection will be communicated to residents by on site personal, if required.

Parking Restrictions and Allowances

- Access to driveways may be restricted at the road closure locations. Residents will be advised of alternative parking areas by on site personnel, if required.
- On-street parking will be restricted during the daytime. Affected residents may park on adjacent streets. Residents are advised not to park where on-street parking is prohibited. There will be no consideration for offences such as No Stopping, No Standing, Stopping on Sidewalks or Boulevards, by Fire Hydrants, Fire Route, Rush Hour Route and parking within 9 metres of intersection.

TTC Service Changes

98 Willowdale-Senlac Bus Route Service Changes: May 23 to June 4, 2011

Southbound buses will be diverted via:

- *Greenwin Village Rd:* One way west from Peckham Road to Chelmsford Avenue.
- *Chelmsford Ave:* One way south from Greenwin Village Road to Moore Park Avenue.
- *Moore Park Ave:* One way east from Chelmsford Avenue to Peckham Avenue.

98 Willowdale-Senlac Bus Route Service Changes: June 6 to June 18, 2011

Northbound buses will be diverted via:

- *Moore Park Ave:* One way east from Cactus Avenue to Hilda Avenue.
- *Hilda Ave:* One way north from Moore Park Avenue to Green Bush Road.
- *Green Bush Rd:* One way west from Hilda Avenue to Cactus Avenue.

Temporary transit stops will be established along the diversion routings.
