

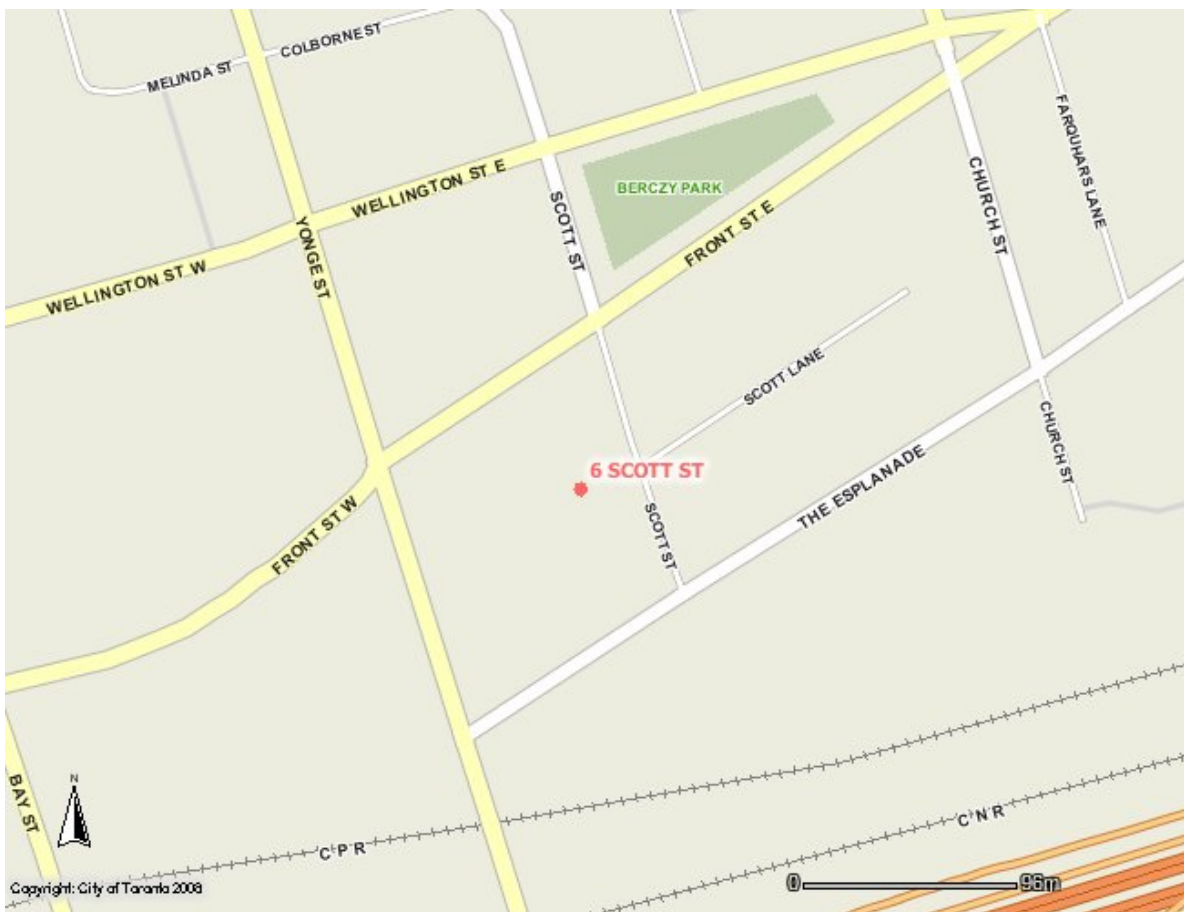

Scott Street Pumping Station Upgrade & Rehabilitation Project

Expected Project Start Date: November 7, 2011
Scheduled Completion Date: September, 2012

The City of Toronto is upgrading and rehabilitating services in the Scott Street Sewage Pumping Station. Commencing November 2011, this work will take place on the west side of Scott Street between Front Street and The Esplanade. Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and appreciated.

Construction Details

The Scott Street Sewage Pumping Station will undergo a full rehabilitation and upgrade of its facilities in order to better meet the needs of the surrounding community. In addition to the installation of a new electrical chamber, the existing dry well will be retrofitted with new equipment allowing for better operation of the station and longevity of the equipment. In

general, construction work will take place over a ten month period and will be localised to the West side of Scott Street. Work will be coordinated with other construction projects in the area to minimise any inconvenience to the surrounding community.

You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or works to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place between 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends only as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences at times. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic and parking restrictions will be necessary, including:

- Both Southbound traffic lanes on the West side of Scott Street will be closed from Front Street to The Esplanade. Two (2) lanes will be maintained on the East side of Scott Street, allowing traffic in both directions.
- Pedestrian access to the sidewalk on the West side of Scott Street will be closed from Front Street to just north of the Esplanade. Emergency egress from the Sony Centre will be maintained at all times.
- At times, and only when completely necessary, three (3) West lanes of Scott Street will be closed. During such closure, only one (1) lane of traffic will be open and flagmen will be positioned at both North and South ends of Scott Street to direct traffic, as per Toronto Transportation requirements.
- Provision will be made at all times for delivery trucks to enter and exit Scott Lane.
- No parking will be permitted on either side of Scott Street for the duration of the construction.

The City looks forward to working with you to allow our Contractor to complete this project in a professional and timely manner. Every effort will be made to reduce any inconvenience you may encounter.
