Rehabilitation of Whitlam Elevated Tank

The City of Toronto will be undertaking restoration, painting and safety upgrades of the Whitlam tank. This project is part of the Toronto City Council-approved 2011 Capital Works Program.

The work will take place within the fenced area surrounding the tank at 1 Whitlam Avenue, Etobicoke.

Scaffolding will be erected on the site by the contractor for the duration of the project. The Majority of the work consists of Exterior and interior painting of the tank and safety upgrades. Other small repairs and restoration work will also be performed.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends only as required.

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. Local traffic and pedestrian access will not be affected. The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience.
