

Watermain Construction at Oriole Park (Oriole Parkway at Chaplin Crescent)

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction Start Date: December 6, 2010
Construction Completion Date: January 14, 2011

Background

Toronto Water is currently constructing a new watermain that will run mostly along Avenue Road between MacPherson Avenue (south end) and Caribou Road (north end). A portion of this project included sheet metal piling to create a shaft at the corner of Oriole Parkway and Chaplin Crescent. This shaft will be used as an entry point to construct underground tunnels beneath this intersection for the new watermain. On November 24, 2010 and December 23, 2010 you were sent notices explaining this work.

Current Status

The sheet metal piling work was successfully completed on Friday January 14, 2010.

The City of Toronto recognizes that the pile driving activity was an inconvenience to residents. We thank you for your patience and understanding as we worked to complete this project as quickly as possible.

The overall project completion date to install the watermain is Late 2012.
