

AVENUE ROAD LANE CLOSURES STARTING Wednesday March 9, 2011

From Cortleigh Boulevard to Glengrove Avenue

Avenue Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction from Cortleigh Boulevard to Glengrove Avenue starting Wednesday March 9, 2011 to August 2011.

Toronto Water is currently constructing a new watermain located mostly along Avenue Road between MacPherson Avenue (south end) and Caribou Road (north end). On November 17, 2011 you were sent a Construction Notice Update explaining this work. If you did not receive a notice, you may contact staff to have a copy mailed to you, or visit the project website listed on the reverse page.

We appreciate your patience during the inconvenience and traffic delays caused by this necessary upgrade to Toronto's drinking water system.

Pedestrian and Vehicle Access

Traffic will be maintained along Avenue Road during construction. Advance traffic warning signs will be posted in the area to advise of traffic restrictions and lane closures and reductions. Access to private and commercial driveways may be temporarily restricted during working hours and will be reinstated at the end of each working day. The Contractor will provide advance notice to property owners for coordination of driveway access.

TTC service will be maintained during construction, but a few bus stops may have to be temporarily relocated.

There may be temporary sidewalk closures. However, the sidewalk on at least one side of the street will remain open at all times to maintain pedestrian access during construction.

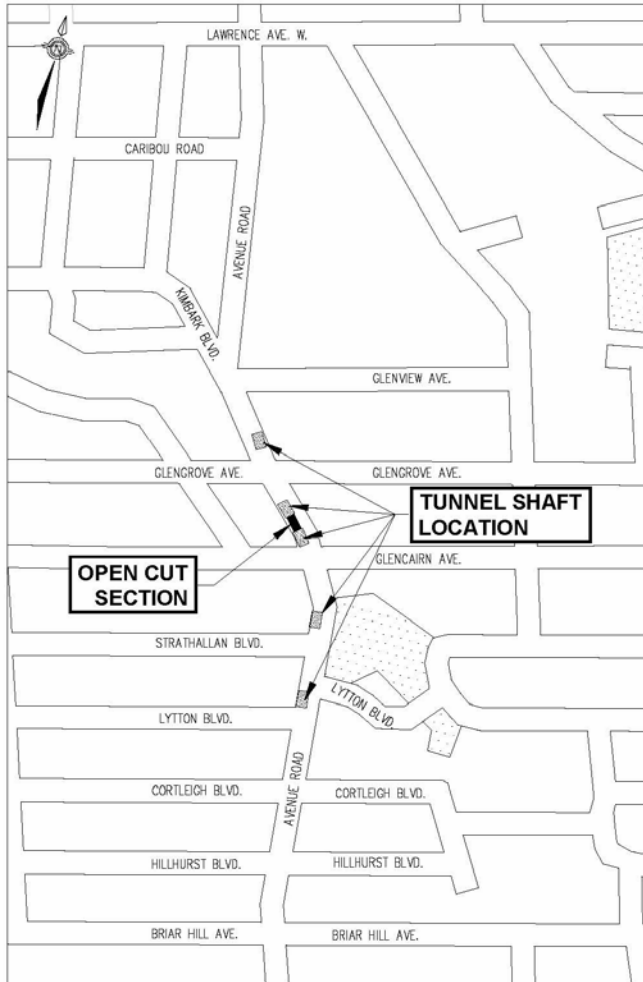
Emergency (police, fire and medical response) access will be maintained at all times.
