

Chaplin Crescent from Oriole Parkway to Avenue Road: Closed to Westbound Traffic

Watermain Construction on Chaplin Crescent

Expected Westbound Lane Closure Start Date: November 14, 2011
Expected Westbound Lane Closure Completion Date: November 25, 2011

Construction Details

The Construction Notice Update sent to you on July 26, 2011 advised that watermain construction on Chaplin Crescent would take place from June 27, 2011 to August 12, 2011. As explained in that Notice, it was necessary to close Chaplin Crescent to westbound traffic so that the Contractor could install several vertical wells to lower the groundwater along that street. Those wells were installed and have served their intended purpose. The next step is to remove the wells and restore the asphalt pavement along Chaplin Crescent.

Chaplin Crescent Closed to Westbound Traffic – November 14 to November 25, 2011

Chaplin Crescent will be closed to westbound traffic between Oriole Parkway and Avenue Road for the removal of the dewatering system and the restoration of the asphalt pavement, commencing on November 14 and ending on November 25, 2011 (see map on the reverse). Southbound traffic on Highbourne Road will not be able to turn right onto Chaplin Crescent. Advance traffic warning signs will be posted in the area to advise of these restrictions.

Access to driveways along Chaplin Crescent may be temporarily restricted during working hours and will be reinstated at the end of each working day. The Contractor will provide advance notice to property occupants for coordination of driveway access.

TTC stops for westbound buses along Chaplin Crescent between Oriole Parkway and Avenue Road will be temporarily relocated and those buses will use Oxtown Avenue instead. Emergency response agencies and the City's office responsible for garbage and recycling collection will be advised of the road restriction.

Recycling and garbage collection will not be affected. Please follow your normal routine.

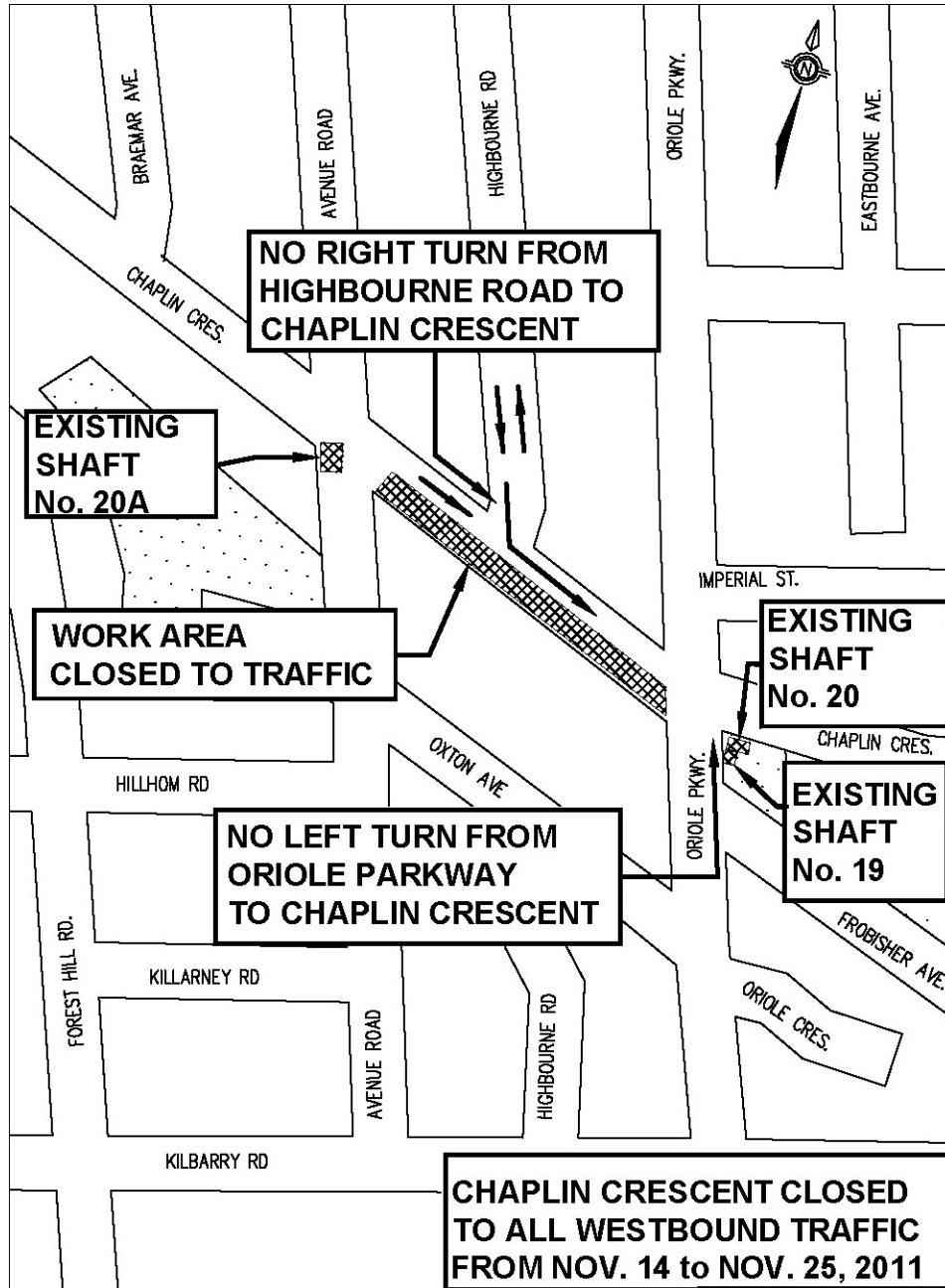
Parking

The City will be installing "NO PARKING" signs along Chaplin Crescent from Oriole Parkway to Avenue Road. To complete construction as quickly as possible, the City will arrange for a tow truck to remove any vehicles that are inadvertently parked on this portion of the street.

Work Hours

Work will generally be carried out between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, but occasionally it may be necessary to carry out work in the evenings and on weekends. The City of Toronto Noise By-law (111-2003) will be complied with throughout the duration of this work.
