Dundas Streetcar Track Reconstruction Full Road Closure on Dundas Street West Between Beverley Street & McCaul Street

This year, the City of Toronto – Transportation Services and the Toronto Transit Commission are replacing the streetcar tracks along the 505 Dundas streetcar route. To do this work, lane restrictions/closures will be imposed on vehicular traffic. The project is progressing on schedule.

Dundas Street from Beverley to McCaul:

Beginning on Saturday, May 19 at 7a.m. through to Tuesday, May 29 at 5a.m., Dundas Street is scheduled to be closed between Beverley Street and McCaul Street in order to carry out track replacement.

Start Date: Saturday, May 19, 2007 *

Completion Date: Tuesday, May 29, 2007*

*Timeline is subject to change due to weather conditions and/or any other unforeseen events

Traffic Restrictions:

A full closure of Dundas Street West from Beverley Street to McCaul Street is required to complete this section of track reconstruction. Construction along this section of Dundas Street West has been co-ordinated with the on-going construction project at the Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO).

Road Closures:

While the closure limits for this section of track reconstruction will be at Beverley Street in the west and McCaul Street to the east, efforts will be made to have westbound traffic divert at University Avenue and eastbound traffic divert at Spadina Ave.

Dundas/Beverley Intersection:

The track work at the intersection of Dundas Street and Beverley Street will be completed with a closure of Beverley Street from 7a.m. Monday, May 21 to 7a.m. Thursday, May 24. Traffic traveling north or south on Beverley Street will not be able to travel through the intersection. South to west right turns will be maintained.

Dundas/McCaul Intersection:

The intersection of Dundas Street and McCaul Street is scheduled for track reconstruction during the Labour Day weekend in September. Details will be provided prior to work commencing.

Work Hours and Noise:

Streetcar track reconstruction is a 24-hour operation. Work associated with rail replacement involves overnight work by TTC track staff after 11 p.m. At times, activities will include pulling the strings of rail from the storage area to the excavated area. The installation of the new rail strings will also include saw-cutting, welding and grinding.

Work at some major intersections, may be carried out with a partial or complete closure and on a continuous 24-hour work basis. Working around-the-clock is a necessity in order to complete the intersection work quickly. During the construction, noise should be expected. However, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of concrete and will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. The work that is not as loud, such as concrete pouring and rail installation will be conducted between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Every effort will be made to limit noise during the overnight work.

Transit Service Changes:

505 Dundas Streetcars: Currently and until further notice, 505 Dundas streetcars are being diverted both ways via: Church Street, Carlton Street and College Street, via Gerrard St. between Parliament St. and Broadview Avenue, due to ongoing track work along Dundas Street. (**See map below**). Customers on the Yonge-University-Spadina subway line can transfer to Dundas streetcars at College Station and at Queens Park Station.
