



Full Intersection Closure for Track Reconstruction

Dundas St. and Ossington Ave. Intersection

This year, the City of Toronto – Transportation Services and the Toronto Transit Commission are replacing the streetcar tracks along the 505 Dundas streetcar route. To do this work, lane restrictions/closures will be imposed on vehicular traffic.

Dundas Street/Ossington Avenue Intersection:

Beginning at 5a.m. on Friday, June 29 through to 5a.m. on Tuesday, July 3, 2007, the intersection of Dundas Street and Ossington Avenue is scheduled for a full road closure in order to carry out track replacement.

Start Date: 5am, Friday, June 29, 2007 *

Completion Date: 5am, Tuesday, July 3, 2007*

*Timeline is subject to change due to weather conditions and/or any other unforeseen events

Traffic Restrictions:

During the track work, the intersection will be closed to all traffic. Traffic travelling north or south on Ossington Avenue or west or east on Dundas Street will not be able to travel through the intersection.

Details:

- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place along the sidewalks at the four corners of the intersection and along the north side of the excavation.
- Temporary pedestrian walkways will be established at each end of the excavation limits of the intersection.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and access to businesses will be maintained during construction.

Road Closure Limits:

Northbound Ossington: Closed at Queen Street, local traffic to Rolyat Street.

Southbound Ossington: Closed at Harrison Street.

Westbound Dundas: Closed at Shaw Street

Eastbound Dundas: Closed at Dovercourt Road, local traffic to Grove Avenue.

Note: Some one-way local streets running off Ossington Avenue just south of Dundas Street will be converted to two-way operation during the intersection work/closure. Signage will be posted.

Work Hours and Noise:

Track reconstruction in the intersection will be completed on a continuous 24-hour basis. Working around-the-clock is a necessity in order to complete the intersection work quickly. During the construction, noise should be expected. However, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of concrete and will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. The work that is not as loud, such as concrete pouring and rail installation will be conducted between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Every effort will be made to limit noise during the overnight work.

Other track Construction:

After work is completed at the intersection, track work will continue on Dundas Street west from Ossington Avenue.

Transit Service Changes:

505 Dundas Streetcars: During this intersection work, Dundas streetcars will be diverted both ways via: College Street (**see transit map#1 on reverse**).

At completion of the Dundas/Ossington intersection work, 505 Dundas streetcars will be diverted both ways via: Bay Street, College Street, Bathurst Street, Dundas Street, Ossington Avenue, College Street, turning back east at Lansdowne Avenue due to on-going track work in the west end of the route. (**see map #2**)

63 Ossington Buses: During this intersection work, Ossington buses will be diverted around the Dundas/Ossington intersection both ways via: Ossington Road, College Street, Bathurst Street, Dundas Street and Shaw Street to route. (**see map#1**).
