



Important Construction Notice



Partial Intersection Closure for Track Reconstruction Dundas Street and Jarvis Street Intersection

This year, the City of Toronto – Transportation Services and the Toronto Transit Commission are replacing the streetcar tracks along the 505 Dundas streetcar route. To do this work, lane restrictions/closures will be imposed on vehicular traffic.

Dundas Street/Jarvis Street Intersection:

Beginning at 7a.m. on Friday, August 17th through to 5a.m. on Monday, August 20th, 2007, the intersection of Dundas Street and Jarvis Street is scheduled for a partial road closure in order to carry out track replacement.

Start Date: 7am, Fri. Aug. 17th, 2007 *

Completion Date: 5am, Mon. August 20th, 2007*

*Timeline is subject to change due to weather conditions and/or any other unforeseen events

Traffic Restrictions:

During the track work, the intersection will be closed to all southbound, northbound, and westbound through traffic. The eastbound traffic lane will be maintained. Traffic traveling north will be diverted at Shuter Street and southbound traffic will be diverted at Gerrard Street. Local traffic traveling northbound on Jarvis will be able to make right turns (eastbound) onto Dundas Street. Due to the narrowness of the road, large vehicles must turn at Shuter Street.

Details:

- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place along the sidewalks at the four corners of the intersection and along the north side of the excavation.
- Temporary pedestrian walkways will be established at each end of the excavation limits of the intersection.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and access to businesses will be maintained during construction.

Road Closure Limits:

Northbound Jarvis: Closed at Shuter with local access to the south construction limit.

Southbound Jarvis: Closed at Gerrard with local access to the north construction limit.

Eastbound Dundas: Traffic lane maintained.

Westbound Dundas: Closed at Sherbourne Street with local access to George Street.

Work Hours and Noise:

Track reconstruction in the intersection will be completed on a continuous 24-hour basis. Working around-the-clock is a necessity in order to complete the intersection work quickly. During the construction, noise should be expected. However, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of concrete and will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. The work that is not as loud, such as concrete pouring and rail installation will be conducted between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Every effort will be made to limit noise during the overnight work.

Transit Service Changes:

505 Dundas Streetcars: Currently, due to on-going track work, 505 Dundas streetcars are diverting both ways via College Street, Ossington Avenue, Victoria Street, Queen Street East, Parliament Street and Gerrard Street. (See Transit Map next page).

141 Downtown / Mt Pleasant Express Buses: As a result of the track work at the Dundas/Jarvis intersection scheduled from 7:00 a.m. on Friday, August 17th, to 5:00 a.m. on Monday, August 20th. Buses on this route will be diverted in both directions as follows. **Note:** This express bus route operates only on weekdays.

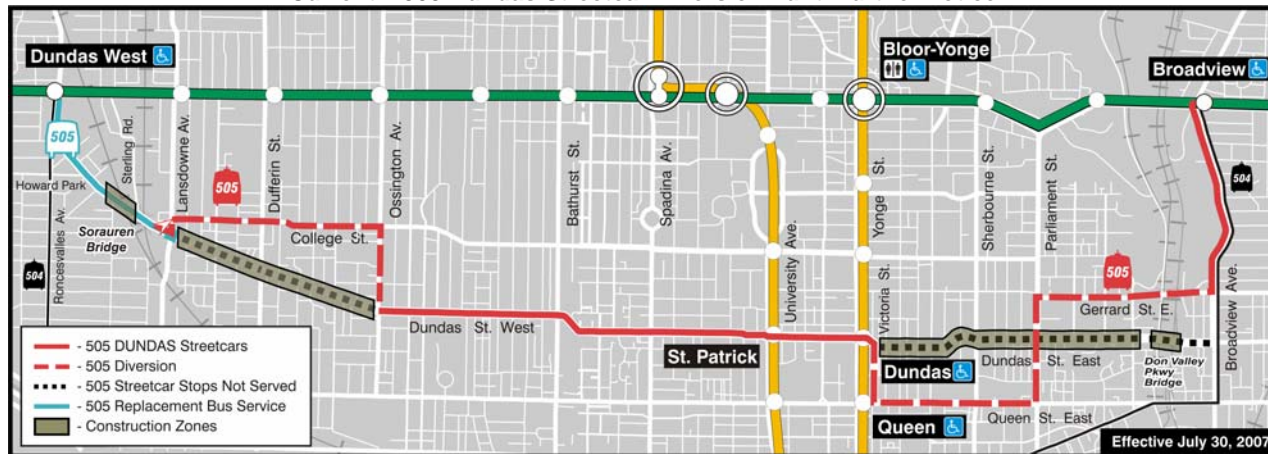
- **Northbound:** From Bay St.; east on Adelaide St., north on Church St., east on Gerrard St., north on Jarvis St. to route.
- **Southbound:** From Bloor St.; south on Jarvis St., west on Gerrard St., south on Church St., west on Richmond St. to route.
