

Dundas Streetcar Track Reconstruction 2007

Crawford Street - Temporary Two-way Traffic

EXTENDED: March 28 to **September 2nd, 2007**

This year, the City of Toronto – Transportation Services and the TTC will be replacing the streetcar tracks on Dundas Street between Howard Park Avenue in the west and Broadview Avenue in the east. During track construction or any preliminary rail work, traffic restrictions on Dundas Street will be imposed in the active construction zones. This will include temporary road closures at some local streets that run off Dundas Street. As a result, some one-way streets will be temporarily converted into a two-way operation in order to provide access for local residents.

Crawford Street – Two-way between Dundas Street and Lobb Avenue

On or about **March 28, and continuing until September 2nd, 2007**, the TTC will carry out some preliminary rail welding work on Dundas Street, east of Ossington Avenue between Shaw Street and Montrose Avenue. The rail welding work will be conducted in the south curb lane resulting in the closure of Crawford Street at the south side of Dundas Street. Crawford Street will be temporarily converted to a two-way operation between Dundas Street and Lobb Avenue for the duration of the rail welding work.

This section of Crawford Street **will continue to be** converted to a two-way operation as the track construction on Dundas Street approaches area.

Two TTC crew trailers will be parked on Crawford Street south of Dundas Street West during the rail welding work and for the duration of the track construction work between Bathurst Street and Ossington Avenue, which is scheduled to be completed in late May 2007.

We regret any inconvenience that may be caused as a result of this conversion.
