



# Important Construction Notice



## Partial Intersection Closure for Track Reconstruction Dundas Street and Yonge Street Intersection

This year, the City of Toronto – Transportation Services and the Toronto Transit Commission are replacing the streetcar tracks along the 505 Dundas streetcar route. To do this work, lane restrictions/closures will be imposed on vehicular traffic.

### Dundas Street/Yonge Street Intersection:

Beginning at 7a.m. on Friday, April 27 through to 5a.m. on Monday, April 30, 2007, the intersection of Dundas Street and Yonge Street is scheduled for a partial road closure in order to carry out track replacement.

**Start Date:** 7am, Friday, April 27, 2007 \*

**Completion Date:** 5am, Monday, April 30, 2007\*

\*Timeline is subject to change due to weather conditions and/or any other unforeseen events

### Traffic Restrictions:

During the track work, one westbound traffic lane on Dundas Street will be maintained through the intersection. No Turns are permitted at this intersection.

Traffic travelling north or south on Yonge Street or east on Dundas Street will not be able to travel through the intersection.

### Details:

- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place along the sidewalks at the four corners of the intersection and along the north side of the excavation.
- Temporary pedestrian walkways will be established at each end of the excavation limits of the intersection.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and access to businesses will be maintained during construction.

### Road Closure Limits:

*Northbound Yonge:* Closed at Queen Street with local access north to Shuter Street.

*Southbound Yonge:* Closed at Edward Street.

*Eastbound Dundas:* Closed at Chestnut Street.

### Work Hours and Noise:

Track reconstruction in the intersection will be completed on a continuous 24-hour basis. Working around-the-clock is a necessity in order to complete the intersection work quickly. During the construction, noise should be expected. However, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of concrete and will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. The work that is not as loud, such as concrete pouring and rail installation will be conducted between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Every effort will be made to limit noise during the overnight work.

### Transit Service Changes:

505 Dundas Streetcars: Currently and until further notice, 505 Dundas streetcars are being diverted both ways via: Church Street, Carlton Street and College Street due to ongoing track work along Dundas Street (**see transit map #1 on reverse**). Customers on the Yonge-University-Spadina subway line can transfer to Dundas streetcars at College Station and at Queens Park Station.

97 Yonge and 320 Yonge Night Buses: During this intersection work, Yonge buses will be diverted around the Dundas/Yonge intersection: Southbound via: South on Yonge Street, west on Gerrard Street, south on Bay Street, east on Queens Quay and north on Yonge Street. Northbound via: North on Yonge Street, west on Richmond Street, north on Bay Street, east on Gerrard Street to Yonge Street to regular routing (**see transit map #2 on reverse**).
