

Dundas Street Track Reconstruction 2007

The City of Toronto and the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) will be replacing the streetcar tracks on Dundas Street from Howard Park Avenue in the west end to Broadview Avenue in the east end, beginning late March 2007 and continuing to late November 2007. In addition, the City of Toronto will be reconstructing the Sorrauren Bridge in the west and the DVP Bridge in the east.

Track construction will occur in phases starting on different dates at different sections of Dundas Street over the course of the project. During construction, there will be temporary changes to the streetcar service on Dundas Street, as well as temporary traffic restrictions.
