

## Etobicoke Waterfront Stormwater Management Facilities Community Working Group

---

The Etobicoke Waterfront Stormwater Management Facilities Community Working Group (CWG) has been established to allow representatives of local community stakeholders an opportunity to provide comments on this study and to ensure that any potential issues are identified early in the study and community input is incorporated. Meetings with the CWG will be scheduled in advance of our three larger public consultation events.

### **Mandate/Role**

The mandate of the CWG will be to work with the project team to:

- Provide input and comments to staff on the stormwater management alternatives;
- Provide advice on evaluation of alternatives;
- Provide advice on proposed siting for stormwater management facilities;
- Review material and provide timely input into the decision-making process.

The CWG will operate as an advisory group to the City of Toronto. While every effort will be made to incorporate the input and comments of this group, final decision-making authority remains with the project team.

### **Membership**

The CWG will consist of 14 members as follows:
