Public Consultation:

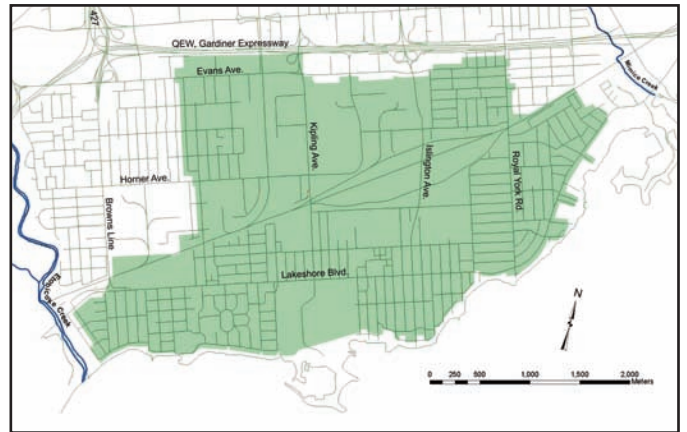

Background:

There are 30 stormwater outfalls along the Etobicoke Waterfront that discharge directly into Lake Ontario. This study, identified in the City's Wet Weather Flow Master Plan, will assess the consolidation of those outfalls and the opportunities for stormwater management. The aim of this study is to improve water quality in Lake Ontario and strive to make our beaches healthy for swimming.
