



Gerrard Street East Track Reconstruction 2006 Public Open House

Beginning in late March and continuing to early June 2006, the City of Toronto and the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) will be reconstructing the streetcar tracks on Gerrard Street East, between Coxwell Avenue and Enderby Road (just west of Main Street). The project will also include some roadway and sidewalk replacement where required. Rail welding and storage will also occur on Gerrard Street, between Main Street and Malvern Avenue.

Transit service will be unavailable along this portion of Gerrard Street and the 506 Carlton streetcars will be re-routed to Bingham loop via Kingston Road for the duration of the project. The new improved streetcar rail will significantly reduce noise and vibration, and is designed to last at least 25 years. Public consultation is an important part of this project. Deputy Mayor Sandra Bussin, the City of Toronto and the TTC invite you to attend a Public Open House to discuss details on this upcoming project.
